of a watercourse, measured from the edge of a watercourse, excluding where such construction will occur behind the development setback line.

- **16.** Construction or earth moving activities in the sea, an estuary, or within the littoral active zone or a distance of 100 metres inland of the high water mark of the sea or an estuary whichever is the greater in respect of-
- (V) infrastructure covering 50 square metres or more
- **18.** The infilling or deposition of any material of more than 5 cubic metres into, or the dredging, excavation, removal or moving of soil, sand, shell, shell grit, pebbles or rock of more than 5 cubic metres from **(i)** a watercourse.
- (iv) the littoral active zone, an estuary or a distance of 100 metres inland of the high-water mark of the sea or an estuary, whichever distance is the greater.
