**PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF THE DORPER WIND ENERGY FACILITY ON A SITE  
NEAR MOLTENO EASTERN CAPE PROVINCE**

**(DEA Reference No. 12/12/20/1778)**

**NOTIFICATION OF APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL  
AUTHORISATION**

Dorper Wind Farm (Pty) Ltd submitted an application for authorisation to the National Department of Environmental Affairs for the proposed construction of the Dorper Wind Energy Facility on a site near Molteno in the Eastern Cape Province (DEA Ref No. 12/12/20/1778). An Environmental Authorisation for the project was received (in terms of 10(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations) on 19 May 2011.

Through subsequent due diligence studies an omission in the listed properties in the Environmental Authorisation was identified. The full extent of the site assessed within the EIA report was correct, however, several farm portions were not specifically listed in the Environmental Authorisation.

The location as described on page 4 and page 5 in the Environmental Authorisation has been requested to be amended as follows: "The wind energy facility is located on: Spreeukloof (portion 18), Paarde Kraal (portion 7), Uitekyk (portions 1 and 3 & remaining extent), Farm 68 (portion 4 & 3 and remaining extent), Cypher Gat (portions 1, 2, 5, 6, 7, and 9 and remaining extent), Bushmans Hoek (remaining extent of portion 3), Highlands (remaining extent), Tolkop (portions 1 and 4) and Post Houers Hoek (remaining extent)."

In terms of Condition 1.7 of the EA, an applicant can apply to the competent authority for a change or deviation from the project description. A request for amendment to the environmental authorisation has been prepared. In terms of Regulation 56 of the EIA Regulations (2010), an opportunity is now provided for registered interested and affected parties to submit written comment on the amendment application.
