AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 23 MARCH 2017 FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE SKUITDRIFT 1 SOLAR PV ENERGY FACILITY ON THE FARM SKUITDRIFT 426 NEAR AUGRABIES WITHIN THE KAI !GARIB LOCAL MUNICIPALITY, NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE.

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued for the above application by this Department on 23 March 2017 and your application for amendment to the EA received by this Department on 26 June 2019 refer.

Based on a review of the reason for requesting an amendment to the above EA, this Department, in terms of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014, as amended, has decided to amend the EA dated, 23 March 2017 as follows:

The following condition is removed from the EA dated 23 March 2017:

Condition 24: *"The holder of the authorisation may apply for an amendment of the EMPr, if such amendment is required before and audit is required. The holder must notify the Department of its intention to amend the EMPr at least 60 days prior to submitting such amendments to the EMPr to the Department for approval. In assessing whether to grant such approval or not, the Department will consider the processes and requirements prescribed in Regulation 37 of GNR982."*

This letter must be read in conjunction with the EA dated 23 March 2017.

In terms of the Promotion of Administrative Justice Act, 2000 (Act No 3 of 2000), you are entitled to the right to fair, lawful and reasonable administrative action; and to written reasons for administrative action that affects you negatively. Further your attention is drawn to the provisions of the Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013 (Act no. 4 of 2013) which stipulates that the Department should conduct itself in a responsible manner when collecting, processing, storing and sharing an individual or another entity's personal information by holding the Department accountable should the Department abuses or compromises your personal information in any way.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended (the EIA Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within

14 (fourteen) days of the date of the EA amendment, of the Department's as well as the provisions regarding the submission of appeals that are contained in the Regulations.

Your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) National Appeal Regulations published under Government Notice R993 in Government Gazette No. 38303 dated 08 December 2014 (National Appeal Regulations, 2014), which prescribe the appeal procedure to be followed. Kindly include a copy of this document (National Appeal Regulations, 2014) with the letter of notification to interested and affected parties in this matter.

Should any person wish to lodge an appeal against this decision, he/she must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party, and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant; or the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the Department, whichever is applicable.
