**NOTIFICATION OF THE GRANTING OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION FOR THE PROPOSED CLEARANCE OF INDIGENOUS VEGETATION AND CULTIVATION OF CROPS ON PORTION 1 OF THE FARM HARRISDALE 226 (KILMOREY), BARKLEY WEST DISTRICT, NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE.**

The purpose of this letter is to notify you as registered Interested and/or Affected Party ("I&AP") that the Department of Environment and Nature Conservation ("DENC") granted Environmental Authorisation ("EA") on 21 October 2019 in terms of the 2014 Environmental Impact Assessment ("EIA") regulations as amended under the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) for the clearance of indigenous vegetation and cultivation of crops on Portion 1 of the farm Harrisdale 226, situated in the Magisterial District of Barkley West in the Northern Cape province.
