Permission is hereby given to **Dr Erich Fisher** in accordance with his application to excavate four Sites in the Pondoland area of the Eastern Cape Province. The Sites earmarked for systematic excavation are as follows:

 2. A3NW-8
 3. B4NW-1
 4. C4NE-1

The Permit is subject to the following conditions:


1. That this permit is not transferable. If the permit holder is not to be present on the site at all times, then the ECPHRA must be provided with the names and qualifications of the authorised representatives;
2. That the excavated material will be kept at East London Museum for the period of analysis after which, they will be transferred to Albany Museum for long term curation
3. That no deviation will be permitted without the prior written approval by ECPHRA. In the event of a proposed deviation, a written motivation must be submitted to the ECPHRA for consideration;
4. An annual progress report on the results of the excavations and analyses must be submitted to the ECPHRA on or before the 30th April 2016 and 30th April 2017.
5. A final report on the work conducted and the findings must be submitted to ECPHRA not later than a year from the date of expiration of this permit;
6. Copies of any papers compiled or published as a result of the work conducted or the findings made must be provided to ECPHRA;
7. If a published report has not appeared within three years of the lapsing of this permit, the report required in terms of the permit will be made available to researchers on request;
8. Where material collected at the sites is to be exported to any country for research or other purposes, a permit must be obtained from SAHRA to do so before the material is exported.

9. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that artefacts are suitably conserved and protected while in his possession;
10. ECPHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
11. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowners for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
12. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to fill in excavations and protect sites during and after excavation to the satisfaction of the heritage authority and the landowner.
13. That ECPHRA reserves the right to inspect the sites at any time and to cancel this permit upon notice to the permit holder;
14. This permit is subject to a general appeal and may be suspended should an appeal against the decisions be received by ECPHRA within 14 days from the date of the permit. ECPHRA may not be held responsible for any costs or losses incurred in the event of the suspension or retraction of this permit.

The issuing of this permit does not exempt the applicant from compliance with any other law, where applicable.

The permit is valid from **April 2015** to **April 2018**.
