Notice is hereby given in terms of Regulation 4 (2) (3) of the National Environmental Management Act (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA): Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations published in Government Notice (GN) R982 and Government Gazette No. 3822, as amended in 2017, under GNR326, 2014, (NEMA: EIA Regulations) that Eskom Holdings (SOC) Limited (Eskom) has been granted with an environmental authorisation (EA) for the relocation of dwellers, the Ingula Relocation Project.

This EA was granted by the Department of Economic, Small Business Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs (DESTEA) on 23 April 2021, and was received by the applicant on 04 May 2021. The EA is issued in terms of the NEMA and associated NEMA: EIA Regulations and gives Eskom approval to undertake the activities listed in Table 1.1.

DESTEA is satisfied based on information available to it, and subject to compliance with the conditions of this EA, that the applicant should be authorised to undertake the activity specified in the authorisation. The EA outlines the decision, the activities authorised, conditions, scope of the authorisation, appeal of the authorisation, management of the activity, monitoring, recording and reporting to the department, commencement of the activity, notification to the authority, operation of the activity, site closure and decommissioning of the activity, and specific conditions (as outlined in the environmental authorisation).
