#### 7.3 Grosvenor Salvage Operation

G. Morcom said that another meeting had been held with Steve Valentine, Chief Conservator, regarding the Grosvenor salvage project. S. Valentine had reported that the project was continuing although there had been problems accessing the wreck site as it was covered by sand. The Board of Trustees supported the continued relationship between East London Museum and the salvors where the Museum remain the receiving museum for artifacts collected from the salvage operation."
