PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

This document provides important information regarding the proposed Copper Sunset Trading 324 (Pty) Ltd (Copper Sunset) project. Copper Sunset is required to amend their existing Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and Environmental Management Programme (EMP) and also need to apply for an integrated water use license (IWULA).

INTRODUCTION

Copper Sunset Trading 324 (Pty) Ltd (Copper Sunset) has an approved EIA/EMP. Digby Wells and Associates (Digby Wells) has been appointed by Copper Sunset to compile

the required documentation for the amendment of their approved EIA/EMP.

Copper Sunset Trading is currently mining sand on the farm Bankfontein 9. The farm is located within the Metsimaholo Local Municipality (Plan 1) and the Fezile Dabi District Municipality in the Free State Province.

The current mining operation involves strip mining in 30 m wide strips with a length of 900 m. The depth of the mine has reached 3.2 m in certain areas and concurrent rehabilitation is being carried out. The mined-out sand is stockpiled on a temporary stockpile until purchased by customers. The sand is loaded from the stockpile onto the customer's vehicles using front-end loaders.

The mine currently has twenty five employees.

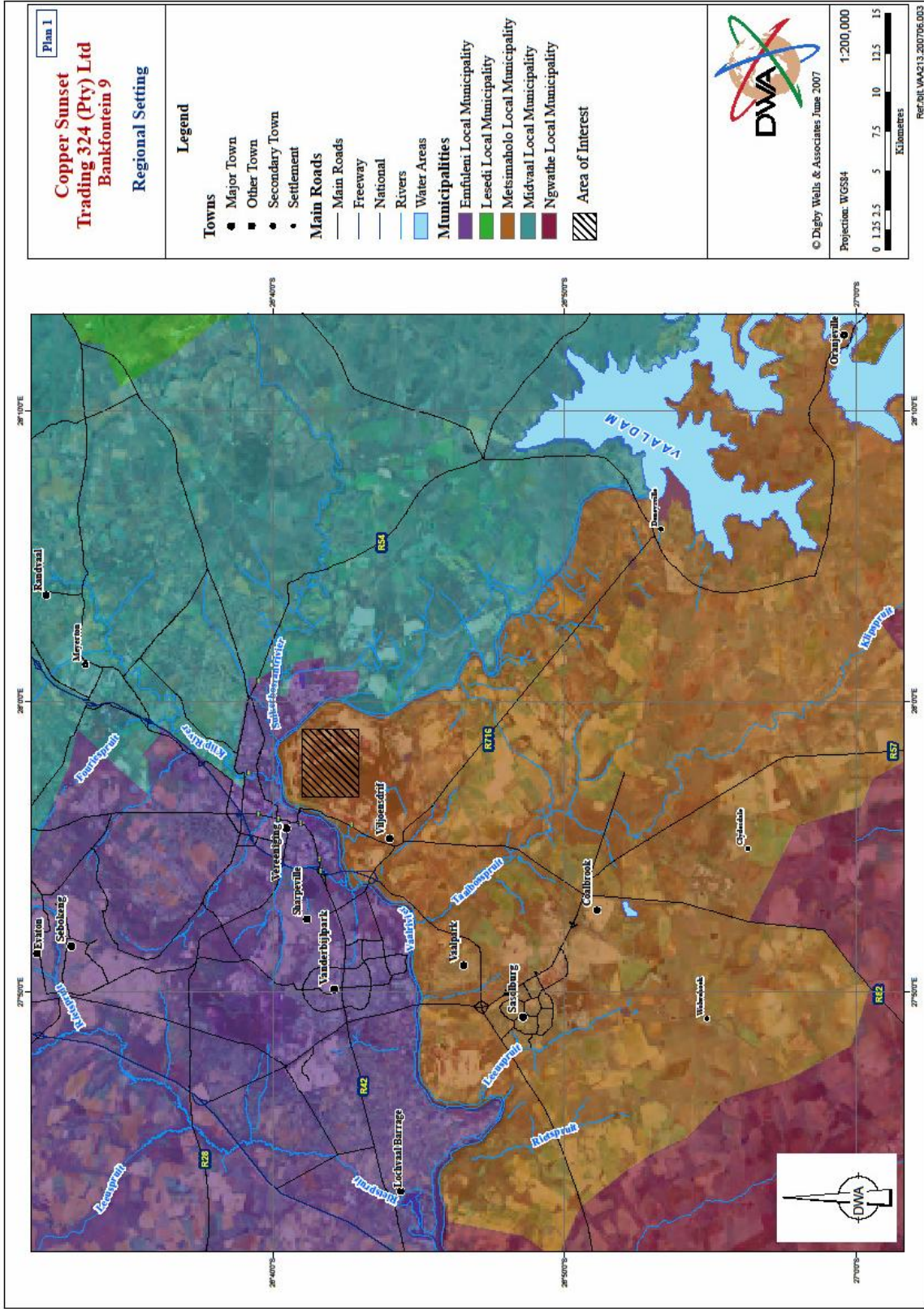
PROJECT INFRASTRUCTURE AND PROCESS

The amendment to the approved EIA/EMP will be to obtain environmental authorisation for the following infrastructure which supports the following process.

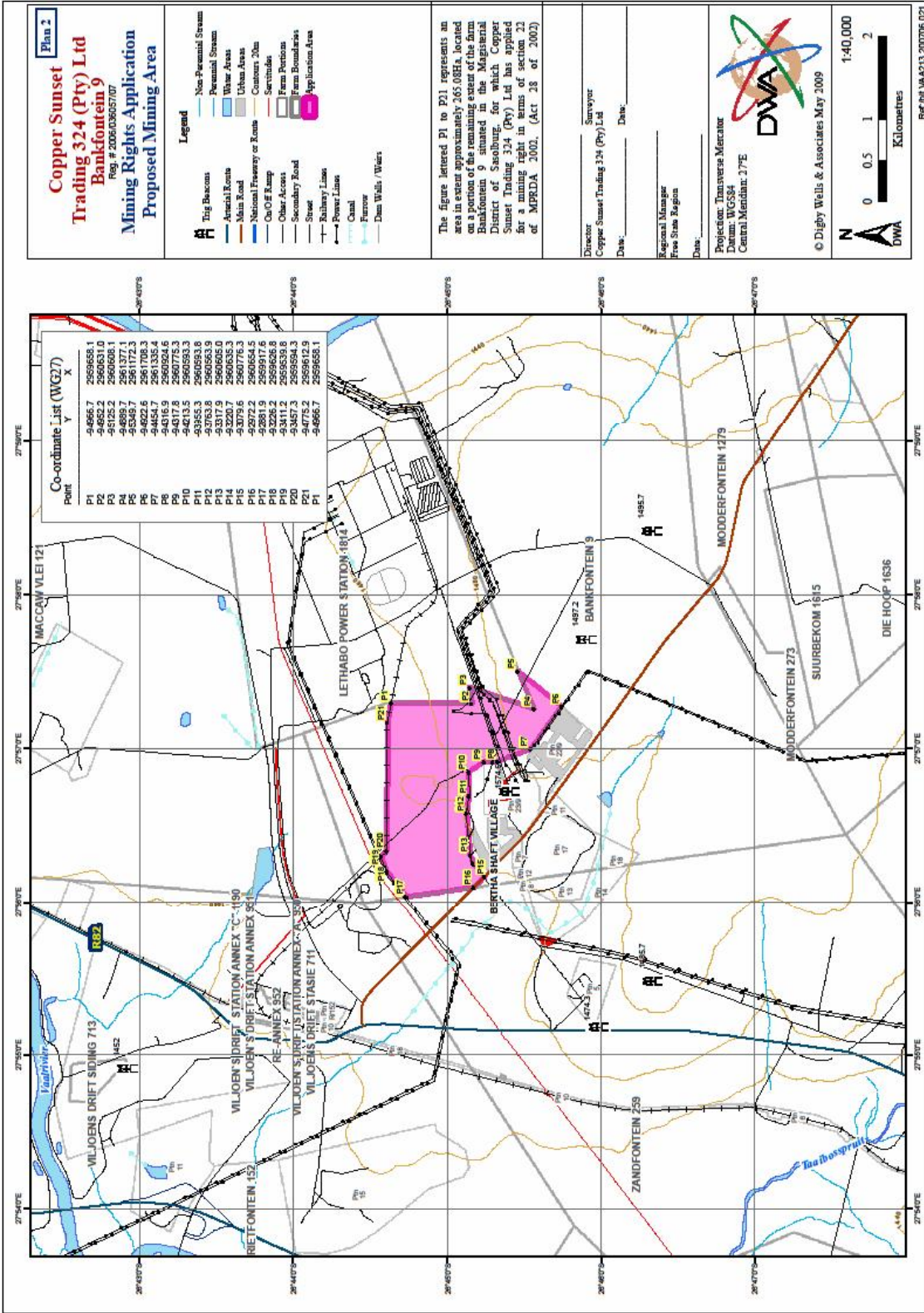
When required, water will be abstracted from a borehole and transported via a pipeline to the return water dam. From there water is transported via a pipeline to the washing plant. Used water from the washing plant will be recycled and thus flows to the settling pond and following the settling process, back to the return water dam and the cycle continues. Please refer to Plan 1 for the regional location of the mine and Plan 2 for the mine plan.

The following infrastructure is required:

- A 140 m x 30 m **washing plant** constructed on concrete flooring, to remove impurities from the mined sand. The plant will require 100 000 litres of water for the rinsing process, per hour.
- A **settling pond** which collects the water from the washing plant and the water is allowed to settle prior to it being returned to the return water dam (below); and
- A **return water dam** used to collect/store extracted water which is to be used for the washing plant. The extracted water is from a borehole on site, and the water is extract only once required and if the water already present in the dam is not sufficient for the washing plant requirements
- It also stores the water which returns from the settling pond, once the settling process has been completed.
- A **structure** to house electrical components.

LEGAL PROCESSES

The following legislation is applicable to the proposed amendment of Copper Sunset's existing EMP:

Minerals and Petroleum Resources Development Act, Act No 28 of 2002 (MPRDA)

A Section 102 application will be made for the amendment to the EIA/EMP. The application will be submitted the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR), Free State Province.

The amended EIA will include an assessment of the possible impacts associated with the washing plant, return water dam, settling pond and structure to house electrical components in addition to an impact evaluation matrix for each aspect of the project. The EMP will detail the mitigation measures for the identified impacts.

All documents will be made available to the public for review before submission to the relevant authorities for environmental authorisation.

National Water Act, Act 36 of 1998 (NWA)

An Integrated Water Use Licence Application (IWULA) will be submitted to the Department of Water Affairs (DWA) for water uses in terms of Section 21 of the act.

The following water uses will require authorisation:

21 (a) - Abstraction of water from a water resource;

21 (b) -Storage of water; and

21 (g) – Disposing of waste or water containing waste in a manner which may detrimentally impact on a water resource.

A technical document will be prepared in accordance with the DWA best practice guidelines, which will further describe the water uses for which Copper Sunset is applying, and their impacts on the surrounding environment.

I&APs will be notified should further water uses be identified.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The public participation process forms an integral part of any environmental impact assessment and water use license application process. It provides an opportunity for I&APs to participate in a meaningful and constructive manner, to raise issues, comments and concerns in respect of the proposed mining operation and environmental authorisation process.

The public participation processes for the EMP amendment and IWULA will be undertaken concurrently to avoid stakeholder fatigue.

Issues identified will be used to inform and guide the environmental and integrated water use license authorisation process.

A draft public participation process report will be compiled and will outline identified issues and concerns.

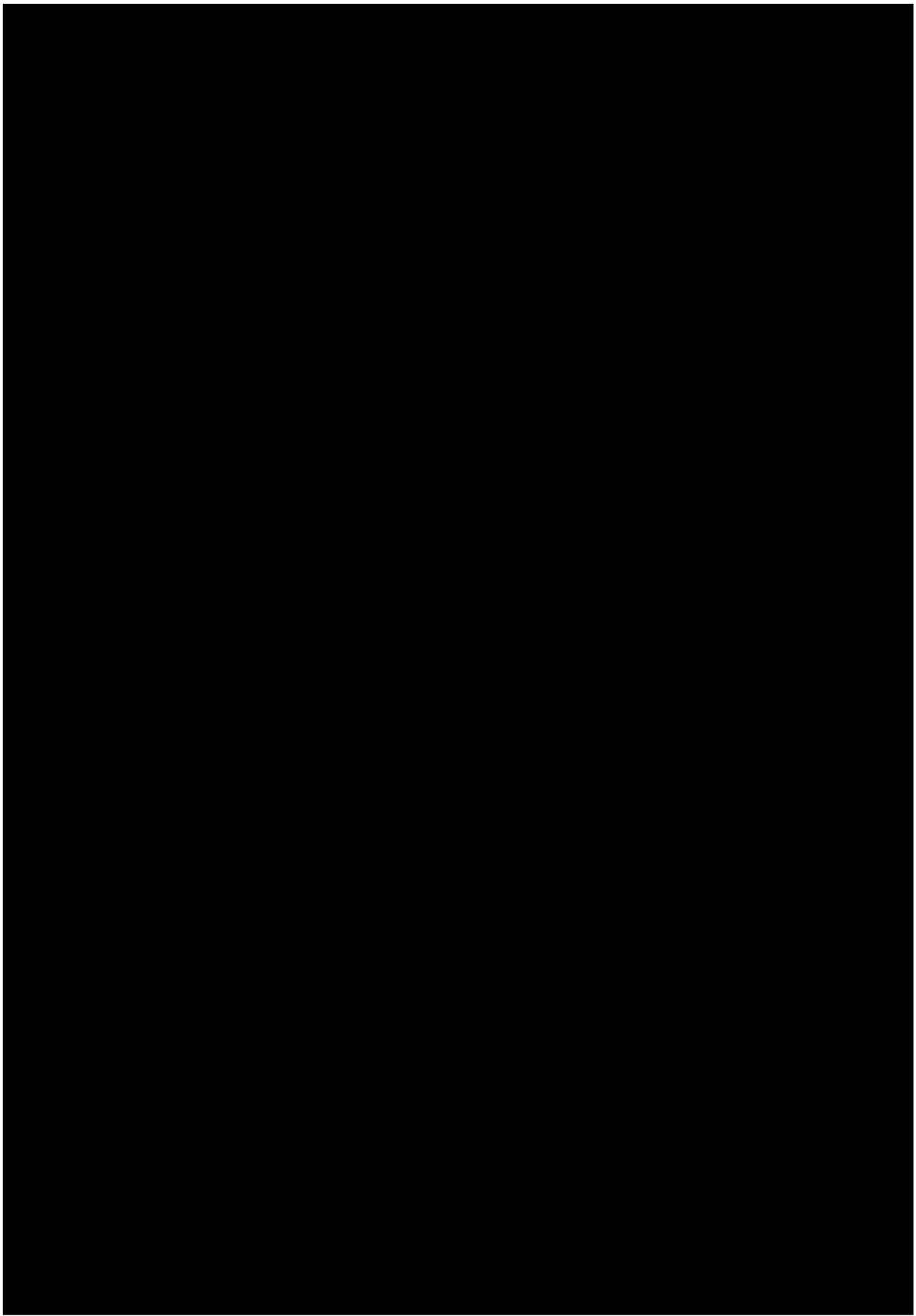

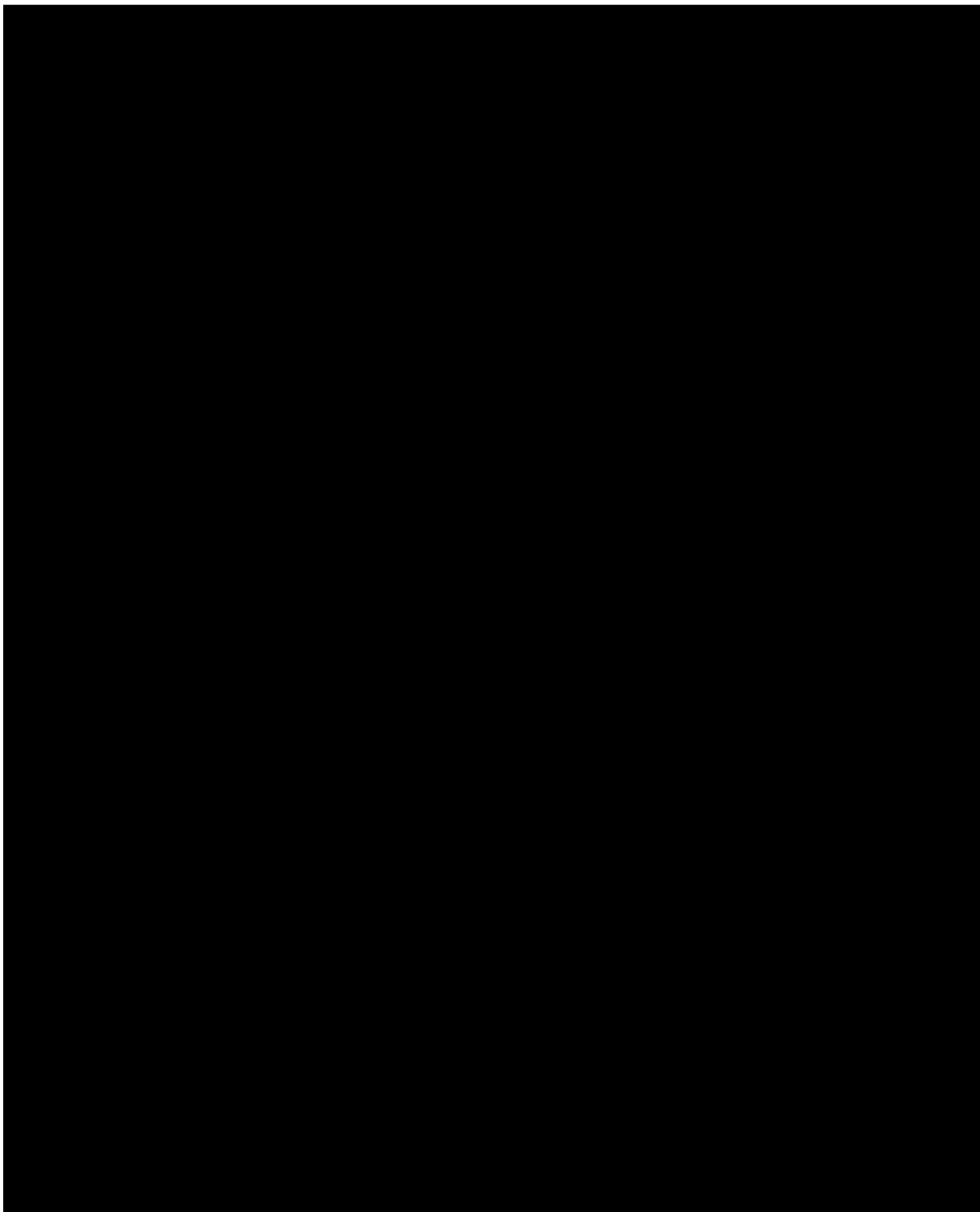

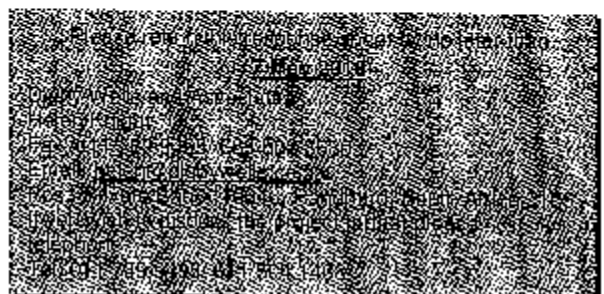
