As you requested, I hereby acknowledge and accept, the Letter of Appointment and the 'Purchase Order', for work to develop a Conservation Management Plan (CMP) for the Joan Broster Beadwork Collection, housed at the Walter Sisulu University (WSU), Mthatha, Eastern Cape.

I shall proceed with the CMP from **1 February 2014**, and as I recall, the original time frame for it was as follows:

- 1 February – 30 April: complete the CMP in draft;
