NOTICE OF A PERMIT APPLICATION FOR THE RELOCATION OF GRAVES IDENTIFIED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION SITE FOR THE EKURHULENI TOWNSHIP AUTOMATIVE AFTERMARKET HUBS IN LABORE BRAKPAN.

Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality is constructing the automotive aftermarket hub in Labore Brakpan within Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality (Please refer to locality map attached).

It is intended that the underway construction of the automotive aftermarket industry is the secondary market of the automotive industry. The project entails the construction of warehouses, storages and offices. The Labore Automotive Hub forms part of the greater Labore Industrial Park currently being developed by the Ekurhuleni Municipality. This project forms part of the larger Labore Industrial Park scheme. This project has an approved Environmental Authorization (EA) together with an approved Phase One Heritage Impact Assessment Record of Decision (RoD) dated 19 June 2018 and issued 12 July 2018. This notice is in relation to the graves identified at the construction phase of the project.

According to Section 36 under Burial grounds and graves of the National Heritage Resources Act 25 of 1999, the graves in South Africa are protected as follows:

"(3)(a) No person may, without a permit issued by SAHRA or a provincial heritage resources authority;

- (a) destroy, damage, alter, exhume or remove from its original position or otherwise disturb the grave of a victim of conflict, or any burial ground or part thereof which contains such graves;
- (b) destroy, damage, alter, exhume, remove from its original position or otherwise disturb any grave or burial ground older than 60 years which is situated outside a formal cemetery administered by a local authority; or
- (5) SAHRA or a provincial heritage resources authority may not issue a permit for any activity under subsection (3)(b) unless it is satisfied that the applicant has, in accordance with regulations made by the responsible heritage resources authority;
- (a) made a concerted effort to contact and consult communities and individuals who by tradition have an interest in such grave or burial ground.

An application process to SAHRA will be submitted for approval to ensure that Heritage issues related to the graves relocation that are associated with the proposed activity are taken into consideration. Interested and Affected parties (I&APs) are invited to comment by providing issues of concern and/or suggestions for

enhanced benefits and/or alternatives; and to ensure that the SAHRA, has sufficient information to make a decision.


