The Directorate: Biodiversity Conservation reviewed and evaluated the report.

Based on the information provided in the report, nationally and provincially protected plant species were observed on site. *Harpagophytum procumbens* subsp procumbens (devil's claw) could be present in the area that the site is situated in, although it was not recorded in walked transects at the time of the assessments. Furthermore, the site is situated in the Griqualand West Centre of Endemism (GWC). Lastly, the Groenwaterspruit and adjacent grasslands dominate the overhead powerlines area.

Given the above, the Directorate Biodiversity Conservation support the proposed amendments with the following recommendations:

- The protected species must be avoided as much as possible. However, in cases whereby avoiding is not possible, relevant permits from the relevant authorities must be obtained for any disturbance of such species.
- Any disturbed areas on site must be rehabilitated with endemic plant species.
- Watercourses and grasslands present suitable habitats for avifaunal species. With the proposed overhead powerlines, there's a risk of collision or electrocution for avifaunal species. Postconstruction monitoring is recommended along with the installation of appropriate bird diverters to minimize the potential risk of collision trauma in birds.
- The Avifaunal Monitoring Programme must comply with all the requirements as outlined in the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) guideline for renewable energy projects and the Best
