NOORD-KAAP—Dit verg fyn voetwerk om verlore persone op te spoor. Die eindresultaat van 'n soektog na 'n vermiste persoon, veral kinders en vrouens, is meestal tragies. Die Departement van Arbeid in die Noord-Kaap het 'n volkskaalse soektog geloods na gewese mynwerkers vir registrasie van onopgeëiste voordele. Dit is dus 'n soektog met 'n meer gelukkige doel.

Voormalige mynwerkers in die John Taolo Gaetsewe-distrik wat in die vroeë 1980's en laat 1990's hul werk verloor het, gaan einde ten laaste na 'n lang stryd en gewag van byna 38 jaar vergoed word.
