Integrated Regulatory Process for Environmental Authorisation, a Waste Management Licence and an Integrated Water Use Licence for the proposed Alexander Mining Project for Sasol Mining (Pty) Ltd, Mpumalanga

Proposed opencast mine and associated infrastructure – Application for:

- Environmental Authorisation (EA) through a Scoping and Environmental Impact Reporting (S&EIR) process and the compilation of an Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act 107 of 1998; NEMA) and its Regulations;
- Waste Management Licence (WML) in terms of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act 59 of 2008; NEM:WA); and
- Integrated Water Use Licence (IWUL) in terms of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act 36 of 1998; NWA), including an Integrated Water and Waste Management Plan (IWWMP).

The EA will be submitted for Alexander under the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (2014, as amended) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (107 of 1998) (NEMA), for the listed activities below:

An Integrated Water Use License (IWUL) Application will be submitted under the National Water Act (36 of 1998) (NWA) and Regulations regarding the Procedural Requirements for Water Use License Applications and Appeals:

Section 21 Water Uses

Section 21 (a) - taking water from a water resource

Section 21 (c) - impeding or diverting the flow of water in a watercourse

Section 21 (f) - discharging waste or water containing waste into a water resource through a pipe, canal, sewer or other conduit


Section 21 (g) - disposing of waste in a manner which may detrimentally impact on a water course

Section 21 (j) - removing, discharging or disposing of water found underground if it is necessary for the efficient continuation of an activity of for the safety of people

Section 21 (i) - altering the bed, banks, course or characteristics of a watercourse

The Department of Water and Sanitation will process the IWUL Application. The EA Application and WML Application will be submitted to the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy Mpumalanga Regional Offices.

The Alexander Mining Project is located approximately 12 km northwest of Bethal and directly to the south and south-east of Kriel in the Mpumalanga Province.
