This survey is part of the RAP socio-economic assessment for the BOSA Transmission Project, which is being undertaken by the Southern African Power Pool (SAPP) and DBSA. The SAPP in collaboration with DBSA (project funder) has identified Botswana-South Africa (BOSA) Transmission Interconnection project as one of the energy pool initiative. SAPP proposes to construct two 400kV transmission power line approximately 210 km and 60m apart, connecting the existing Isang 400kV substation in Botswana to the Watershed B area near Mahikeng.
