Sir,

Your letter of 16 November 2009 refers  
- Regarding prospecting rights on the farm  
Harrissdale 330 District Gordonia

I wish hereby to lodge an objection. This is  
a private farm and we allow no access  
to our property.

We are busy having the farm declared a  
private Game Reserve. If your staff will  
be on the farm, they may not carry any  
firearms or snares or traps.

No smoking, matches, lighters etc will be  
allowed, or any other gadgets that can cause  
a fire. All these will have to be placed  
in our safe keeping. We accept no  
responsibility for any loss occurred.

As some of the terrain is very sandy with high dunes, your vehicles will not be allowed to leave the existing track or road. No material (eg. grass etc) is to be uprooted when vehicles get bogged down.

As this is private property my staff have the right to use our vehicles on the farm roads. When travelling over the dunes which is a one way road, it is impossible to see oncoming vehicles. Some of my staff do not have a driving licence (although competent). You will be held responsible for any damage to my vehicles or injury to my staff or myself or son, should an accident occur. I will not be held responsible for damage or injury to your vehicles or staff.

I would like to point out to you that the South African Agricultural Union have a Supreme Court case regarding prospecting and mining rights on private properties. To the best of my knowledge the court case is still ongoing.

All Aerial photographs and other information gathered by you is to be sent to us immediately. It is an infringement to "spy" on our personal property.
