
The process flow of the new facility, as provided by Scaw, is appended to the memo.


2.0 ASSESSMENT

Upon assessment of the information provided, the following listed activities in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (GN R 544, 545 and 546 in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 107 of 1998, GNR 718 in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 59 of 2008, and requirements for water authorisations) have been identified as potential triggers.
