Middle-class earners must pay upfront for stands

The Middle Class Earners committee members are livid after Msukaligwa Municipality allegedly reneged on a payment agreement regarding stands made available for them in Ext 7 in Wesselton.

According to the committee chairman, Mr Jabu Mahlangu, the municipality is allegedly asking for full payment upfront before members can begin to build on their stands.

The municipality confirmed this when the *Highvelder* enquired at the municipal offices.

According to the municipal spokesman, Mr Mandla Zwane, those buying stands in Ext 7 must pay R40 000 before they can get a stand.

"We sent out offer to purchase letters in February where it clearly stated buyers must pay the fee," Mr Zwane said.

The *Highvelder* is in possession of such a

letter.

However, the committee does not approve of this and is adamant a resolution approved by council in July 2017 states the committee members can pay the R40 000 fee in instalments of up to 36 months.

After enquiries, Msukaligwa revealed the resolution in question was revoked during another council sitting in December 2017 during which the council rescinded the previous resolution of the 36 months payment method as it is forbidden in terms of Section 164 of the Municipal Finance Management Act.

This means it is against the law for the municipality to make loans with certain borrowers, including members of the public.

The committee said it was not aware of

this.

The *Highvelder* is in possession of the second resolution.

"We were not told of this resolution and are surprised about these developments," Mr Mahlangu said.

The *Highvelder* sought a neutral legal opinion in the matter.

The person said if there is a resolution that revoked the initial resolution, then the committee will have to pay for their stands upfront.

However, they questioned why there was such a resolution in the first place if the municipality knew about Section 164.

Another legal eye perused documents at the newspaper's disposal and was in agreement with the first one, saying the Middle Class Earners committee and its members have no choice but to pay the fee upfront.

"The municipality is within their rights to revoke a resolution," he added.

This does not bode well for the committee that thinks the municipality is going back to the original agreement.

The committee has had a long-standing fight with the council regarding the issue of land in Ext 7 and picketed outside the municipal offices in November last year to

protest over the price of the stands.

Members of the committee are from the middle-class community who cannot get government housing or benefits and do not qualify for a bond at banks.

Various political parties are against the selling of stands in Ext 7. The South African Communist Party (SACP) strongly condemned the process and stated they did not recognise the committee.

The Economic Freedom Fighters (EFF), however, has taken a softer stance, saying people should get stands for free.

This is a developing story and the *Highvelder* will be following it closely.

Men rob shop in Wesselton

Ermelo Police are investigating a case of armed robbery after two men had broken into a shop in Wesselton on Thursday, 12 July at 7.30pm.

According to the police spokesman, Capt Carla Prinsloo, a 49-year-old man said he was closing his shop in Wesselton when he was confronted by two men who forced his shop open. One of the men was armed and hit the owner of the shop over the head with the firearm.

"The men stole cash, airtime coupons and cigarettes from the shop before they fled on foot," said Capt Prinsloo. Anyone with information that can help the investigation, can contact Lt Col Brian Tsela at 017 819 2321 or 017 819 2328.

Police arrest two for dagga

Two men were arrested for possession of marijuana on the Dundonald and Waverly road in Mayflower on Sunday, 15 July.

According to Mayflower Police's spokesman, Const Tryphina Utla, two police officers from the Waverly port of entry were patrolling the Glenmore and Dundonald road at 14.55pm when they saw two men walking in the road carrying bags.

"The police stopped in their marked vehicle, introduced themselves and requested permission to search their bags," Const Utla said. One of the suspects was found with three rolls of the drug wrapped in brown tape in his bag, weighing 3.56kg with a street value of R10 000, while other suspect was found with two rolls of the drug wrapped in brown tape, weighing 4.4kg with a street value of R15 000.

The two suspects appeared in the Mayflower Periodical Court on Monday.

Man arrested for rape

A 65-year-old man was arrested for the rape of a 15-year-old girl on Sunday, 15 July at the Glenmore Section in Mayflower.

According to Mayflower Police's spokesman, Const Tryphina Utla, the alleged rape took place on 21 June when the victim was walking home from church choir practice. She was accompanied by two boys at 6pm when they passed the suspect's house.

"The suspect stopped the three teenagers and asked the two boys to go buy bread and cigarettes for him at a nearby shop, leaving the girl behind. She was then allegedly raped," Const Utla said.

She added the victim did not tell anybody until 12 July when the two boys informed one of the church elders that they were going to the suspect's house to collect money from the suspect, who paid them for sleeping with the victim.

According to reports, the suspect tried to bribe the grandmother of the victim not to report the matter. The suspect appeared in the Mayflower Periodical Court on Monday, 16 July. The case was postponed to Monday, 23 July and the suspect remains behind bars.

Three caught for dealing

Three men were arrested after being found with marijuana on Friday, 13 July in Fernie. The police were conducting a routine stop and search as part of crime prevention.

"W/O Zweliyabona Madonsela and Const Thabani Ngwenya stopped three men and found marijuana weighing 8kg," Const Magagula said.

They will appear in court on 6 August.

Farm residents want better lives on farms

Residents of farms around Msukaligwa took to the streets of Ermelo to protest over the oppression and poverty they face daily on the farms on Friday, 13 July.

The residents, collectively named the Msukaligwa Emmapulazini Forum, marched to the Department of Rural Development and Land Reform for assistance regarding the issue of land and basic service delivery on farms.

The forum asked the department to give them written permission to do mix farming through cooperatives, which they said would create jobs and fight poverty on the farms.

According to the forum, people living on farms owned by white people are still physically, mentally, socially and emotionally oppressed and work like slaves and earn small wages.

The forum asked the department to intervene and requested that land should be shared equally in good spirit and faith by developing a partnership agreement.

This they said would help them as residents to gain farming experience in

management and administration.

The Emmapulazini Forum also handed over a memorandum to the heads of department with a list of demands that include:

- As farm residents, they asked the department to treat them as human beings and provide basic services such as low-cost housing, water, electricity and sanitation.

- The councillors and ward committee members who are recognised by local government must be elected by farm residents and not just be appointed by the powers that be.

- Residents requested that government, through the Rural Development and Land Reform Department, speeds up processes of land claims.

- A land claim office to be allocated in Msukaligwa so that farm residents do not have to travel long distances to submit land claims.

- The process of appointing people to work on farms owned by the department be revisited, because residents of the farms have been staying there since the apartheid era.

"The department fails to introduce these people, and residents feel they are encroaching on the land and government should consider giving these farms to families living there," Mr Ignatius Mahlangu, chairman of Msukaligwa Emmapulazini Forum, said.

Ms Zandile Shongwe accepted and signed the memorandum on behalf of the Department.

Emmaus Group helps Ngwenya family with wheelchair and food

The Walk to Emmaus Group from the Methodist Church of Ermelo, accompanied by the Department of Social Development officials, visited the Ngwenya family in Ethembeni Informal Settlement to hand over a wheelchair and groceries on Monday, 16 July.

As previously reported by the *Highvelder*, "Ngwenya family lives in abject poverty in informal settlement" on 13 July, Ms Lillian Ngwenya and her grandson, Lindokuhle Ngwenya, make do with only the social grant money to survive.

Ms Ngwenya relies on neighbours and takes care of her grandson, Lindokuhle, who has special needs and does everything for him and two grandchildren who are still in school.

Lindokuhle (24) is bedridden and has been confined to bed since birth with no diagnosis forthcoming as to what is wrong with him and it is highly unlikely that he will be diagnosed soon as there is no money for healthcare or transport to visit a public healthcare facility.

Due to a lack of funds, Ms Ngwenya uses cloth as makeshift diapers so Lindokuhle does not defecate on himself.

The Emmaus group, comprising church elders and leaders in the community, sang songs of worship. Rev Thokozani Mthembu led in prayer. They handed over a wheelchair for Lindokuhle and groceries to feed the household of four.

The *Highvelder* has received various items from the community to help the family.

Illegal connections reason for outages

Numerous cables were confiscated during the disconnection of illegal electrical connections in Khayelihle, Wesselton Ext 1, 2, 3, 4, 6 and Enkanini on 3 and 5 July.

Msukaligwa Municipality, working with the police, undertook the operation to curb what has become the norm in Wesselton where residents of informal settlements and surrounding areas are connecting electricity illegally.

The operation came as the municipality's electricity section is experiencing unplanned incessant electricity outages in Ext 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6 in Wesselton.

The major cause of these electricity outages is the illegal electricity connections which cause the network to overload and trip because the demand exceeds the supply, meaning there are more people who use electricity than what the network was designed for.

Eskom has also warned the public against infrastructure and electricity theft which includes illegal electricity connections.

According to Eskom, the fact that electricity theft costs the country approximately R20 billion per year, may not be easy to comprehend for many ordinary citizens and suffering serious injuries due to coming into contact with electricity becomes an immediate threat and reality for many South Africans.

"Our major concern in the case of illegal connections is that danger is posed not only to the people who engage in illegal connections, but also to the rest of their community, particularly children and animals," Eskom's divisional executive of Security, Mr Tebogo Rakau, said.

This is indeed a reality as a woman died in November last year when she was electrocuted in Ethembeni, Wesselton.

According to a resident, the woman had

no shoes on and was connecting a power line from a nearby connected house when she was electrocuted.

This led to leaders intervening as it is not just cable thieves doing the connections anymore, but ordinary citizens as well.

One leader at the informal settlement condemned the illegal connections, but lamented the fact that his hands are tied because the municipality is allegedly doing nothing to provide for the community in terms of installing electricity.

Eskom is encouraging all community members to report any unsafe and illegal power conditions or connections that they come across by calling 086 003 7566.

These include exposed electrical wiring, low-hanging cables, illegal connections, vandalised electrical equipment such as substations and exposed electrical cables due to theft or vandalism.

The public can also report electricity and infrastructure theft anonymously by sending an SMS to the Crime Line's SMS line at 32211.

Or alternatively call 0800 11 2722.

The identity of those who report theft incidents remains completely protected at all times.

The municipality also appealed to community members to report any illegal connections to the municipal call centre at 086 116 7852, 079 503 6729 and 079 503 5484.

They urged electricity users to use it sparingly by switching off unused electric appliances.

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

Without able of finally putting in a nail in the coffin of those thought processes jumping to the conclusion of worldwide manipulation, it surely makes for some riveting reading.



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Should you sell in a down market, or not?

Economists have downgraded their outlook for the property market this year.


