INTRODUCTION

This Background Information Document (BID) serves to notify the public of the intention of the KNS Piggery (Pty) Ltd to apply for an environmental authorisation, under the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), and the National Environmental Management Waste Act GNR. 921 of 29 November 2013 for the proposed development of the KNS Piggery Sow Unit Piggery in the outskirts of Emakhazeni in Emakhazeni Local Municipality, Mpumalanga Province.

Information Decision Systems (Pty) Ltd (IDS) has been appointed by the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and Environment (DFFE) to manage the Special Needs and Skills Development Programme which is aimed at providing pro-bono environmental services to qualifying businesses. Under this programme, IDS undertakes Basic Assessments (BAs) for applicants who can demonstrate that they have "special needs", in particular, where applicants cannot afford to undertake the necessary BA process. This led to the IDS undertaking this BA for proposed agribusiness development of 100 sow unit piggery farm project on Sibiya family claim area situated in Emakhazeni Local Municipality, Mpumalanga Province.

Information Decision Systems (Pty) Ltd (IDS)) on behalf of KNS Piggery 100 Sow Unit Piggery as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to undertake the process required to apply for Environmental Authorisation from the Mpumalanga Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, Land and Environmental Affairs (MDARDLEA).

- Understand the applicable environmental authorisation process in order to participate meaningfully.


PROJECT OVERVIEW

The KNS Piggery (Pty) Ltd aims to establish an agricultural business through the 100 sow unit piggery (**Table 1**). KNS piggery intends to rear and sell pigs for slaughter. The pigs are to be sold to local abattoirs which supply the local market with pork products. The capacity of the piggery facility will cater for 100 sow to eventually 250 sow. Artificial insemination will be used in the breeding process. Three facilities will be erected for the purpose of the piggery, these include mating and gestation house, furrowing and weaner house and a grower and finisher house. A slurry dam and shower house will also be erected in the piggery. As a future plan, an abattoir and cold storage will be developed.




Figure 1: Site Plan

ENVIRONMENTAL SENSITIVITY

The study area is situated within Critical Biodiversity Area and Ecological Support Area. The study area falls within 32 meters watercourse perimeters.

ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION PROCESS

Environmental authorisation is being applied from the Mpumalanga Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, Land and Environmental Affairs (MDARDLEA) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA) (Act No.108 of 1998) and the 2014 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations as amended in April 2017 read with National Environmental Management Waste Act GNR. 921 of 29 November 2013.

Basic Assessment Process

The proposed development of KNS piggery 100 sow listed activities in Listing Notice 1 (GN R. 327) and Listing Notice 3 (GN R. 327) of the EIA Regulations 2014 as amended in April 2017 and the National Environmental Management Waste Act GNR. 921 of 29 November 2013. Consequently, these activities require the undertaking of a Basic Assessment inclusive of technical studies and public participation.
