INTRODUCTION

This Background Information Document (BID) serves to notify the public of the intention of the Dihlaping Aquaculture Projects to apply for environmental authorisation, under the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) for the proposed establishment of an agri-business through the development of aquaponics and poultry in Maletswai Village within the jurisdiction of Waterberg District Municipality.

Information Decision Systems (Pty) Ltd (IDS) has been appointed by the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and Environment (DFFE) to manage the Special Needs and Skills Development Programme which is aimed at providing pro-bono environmental services to qualifying businesses. Under this programme, IDS undertakes Basic Assessments (BAs) for applicants who can demonstrate that they have "special needs", in particular, where applicants cannot afford to undertake the necessary BA process. This led to the IDS undertaking this BA for the proposed Mozambican tilapia aquaponics farm project in Maletswai Village on the Farm ROOIPORT 173, located in the outskirts of Lephalale in the Waterberg District Municipality.

Information Decision Systems (Pty) Ltd on behalf of Dihlaping Aquaculture Projects as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to undertake the process required to apply for Environmental Authorisation from the Limpopo Department of Economic Development Environment and Tourism (LEDET).

PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

The purpose of this document is to provide members of the public with information about the proposed project. This information will allow readers to:

- Determine whether they are an Interested and Affected Party (I&AP).
- Understand the project in order to provide informed comments.
- Understand the applicable environmental authorisation process in order to participate meaningfully.

PROJECT OVERVIEW




Figure 1: An illustration of the reticulating aquaculture system aquaponics

Dihlaping Aquaculture Projects aims to establish an agri-business through the development of aquaponics (a combination of aquaculture and hydroponics). Production will be based on Recirculating Aquaculture System (RAS) (**Figure 1**). The RAS system will consist of 6 ponds on 36m² of land. Each pond will grow 35tons of Mozambique Tilapia (**Figure 2**) and a tunnel system will be established for vegetables. The facility will have an office, ablution facilities, solar system, purification wetland, backup generator, workshop and storage facilities.




Figure 3: Site Plan

ENVIRONMENTAL SENSITIVITY

The study area is situated within Critical Biodiversity Area. The study area is within 100m of Palala River and within 500m of a wetland as indicated by Wetlands Map 5.

ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION PROCESS

Environmental authorisation is being applied for from the Limpopo Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism (LEDET). in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA) (Act No. 108 of 1998) and the 2014 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations as amended in April 2017.

Basic Assessment Process

The proposed aquaponics farm triggers listed activities in Listing Notice 1 (GN R. 327) and Listing Notice 3 (GN R. 327) of the EIA Regulations 2014 as amended in April 2017. Consequently, these activities require the undertaking of a Basic Assessment inclusive of technical studies and public participation.
