Hi Nicole,

I refer to our telephonic conversation.

I have not been able to find the report on SAHRIS but I have checked previous assessments in the same area conducted by Mr. Anderson as well as Eastern Cape Heritage Consultants cc. It does not appear that there will be any serious archaeological heritage issues related to this proposal. The standard recommendations should be followed in the event of any archaeological finds during vegetation clearing and construction and this needs to include consultation with the affected community.

In view of the above there will be no need for a focus group meeting for the proposed development.

Please forward the archaeological opinion letter compiled by Mr. Anderson for our record purposes as soon as it becomes available.
