

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR RECTIFICATION:

UNLAWFUL COMMENCEMENT OR CONTINUATION OF ACTIVITIES IDENTIFIED IN TERMS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS IN TERMS OF SECTION 24G, READ WITH SECTION 7 (TRANSITIONAL PROVISION) OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT AMENDMENT ACT (ACT NO. 8 OF 2004).

Notice is given in terms of Section 24(G) read together with Section 24 (F) of the National Environmental Management Amendment Act (as amended) that the Gauteng Department of Agriculture and Rural Development has considered an application for rectification by Lothlorien Paper in terms of Section 24(G) and 24(F) of the National Environmental Management Amendment Act (as amended) – for the unlawful commencement of activities listed in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment regulations under the sub-regulations of Government Notice R718 of 3 July 2009, promulgated in terms of section 19(1) of the National Environmental Management Waste Act (NEMWA): for

- The proposed Section 24G Rectification Application for the unlawful storage and sorting of general waste (Ref No.: S24G/05/12-13/0035).
- The activity is listed under the sub-regulations of Government Notice R718 as:
 - *The storage, including the temporary storage of general waste at a facility that has the capacity to store in excess of 100m³ of general waste at any one time, excluding the storage of waste in lagoons, and*
 - *The sorting, shredding, grinding or bailing of general waste at a facility that has the capacity to process in excess of one ton of general waste per day.*
