

Only appeals on environmental grounds can be considered. All appeals should be accompanied by relevant supporting documentation.

In the event that an appeal is lodged with regard to this authorisation, the listed activities described in this authorisation may not commence prior to the resolution of the appeal and prior to the Department's written confirmation of compliance with all conditions that must be met before construction can commence, whichever event is the latter.

1. Decision

Environmental Authorisation dated 07/09/2012 is hereby amended in terms of Regulation 38 (2) (a) an (3 (D)) of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations of 2010 to address the following:

- 1. Conditions 4.48 and 4.53 to read: where concrete is mixed in the designated points;
- 1.1. This must not take place within 32metres from a water course.
- 1.2. It be mixed in plastic sheeting and on top of shutter boards to avoid soil contamination.
- 1.3. A soil berm must be built around the mixing area to stop any potential run off.
- 1.4. Where top soil is removed, this must not be in vegetated areas, use of bare surface 32 metres away from a watercourse is recommended.
- 1.5. The top soil must not be mixed with other materials, rather stockpiled for re-filling at a site closure and decommissioning phase or post construction.
- 1.6. Concrete mixing personnel must be trained on the method statement dated 16 October 2012, these amendment conditions, the Environmental Management Programme Report and the Environmental Authourisation dated 07 September 2012.
- 1.7. The resident engineer shall determine the amount of concrete required on site and each area on a daily basis.
- 1.8. Concrete remaining on campsite must be on impermeable surface.
- 1.9. Cleaning of working tools must take place at designated area at campsite only.
- 1.10. The area where concrete was mixed must be cleaned on completion of the mixing and placement at required points.
- 1.11. The ground must not be compacted, other than at the required points.
- 1.12. The ECO must oversee compliance with these amendment stipulations and the original Environmental Authourisation dated 12 September 2012.

6. Appeal of amendment authorisation

- 6.1 The holder of the authorisation must notify every registered interested and affected party, in writing and within 12 (twelve) calendar days of the date of this environmental authorisation, of the Department's decision to authorise the activity.
- 6.2 The notification referred must:
 - a) specify the date on which the authorisation was issued;
 - b) inform the interested and affected party of the appeal procedure provided for in Chapter 7 of the regulations;
 - c) advise the interested and affected party that a copy of the authorisation will be furnished on request; and
 - d) give the reasons for the decision.
- 6.3 The holder of the authorisation must publish a notice:
 - a) informing interested and affected parties of the decision;
 - b) informing interested and affected parties where the decision can be accessed; and
 - c) drawing the attention of interested and affected parties to the fact that an appeal may be lodged against this decision.
