NOTIFICATION OF AMENDMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION

Kotulo Tsatsi Energy (Pty) Ltd obtained an Environmental Authorisation (EA) for the 200MW SolarReserve Kotulo Tsatsi CSP 2 and its associated infrastructure on Portion 2 and 3 of the farm Styns Vley 280, Northern Cape Province (DEA Ref: 14/12/16/3/3/2/694/2).

An application to amend the EA was submitted in June 2017. Please refer to the EA amendment letter from the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) dated 20 July 2017 for details regarding the amendments applied for.

The applicant is duly notifying all registered interested and affected parties, as instructed by the decision issued by the DEA, and in terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended, of the outcome of the application for amendment. The Department of Environmental Affairs amended the Environmental Authorisation in line with the above on 20 July 2017.

As a registered interested and affected party, your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of the National Appeals Regulations, 2014, which prescribes the appeal procedure to be followed. Should any person wish to lodge an appeal against this decision (to amend the EA), he/she must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party, and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the Department (i.e. 24 July 2017).
