AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 03 MAY 2016 FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF THE SUBSTATION AND ANCILLARIES FOR THE AUTHORISED KARUSA WIND FARM NEAR SUTHERLAND WITHIN THE KAROO HOOGLAND LOCAL MUNICIPALITY OF NAMAKWA DISTRICT IN NORTHERN CAPE

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued for the abovementioned application by this Department on 03 May 2016, the application for amendment to the EA received by this Department on 20 January 2017 and additional information received on 16 February 2016 refer.

Based on a review of the reason for requesting an amendment to the above EA, this Department, in terms of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, has decided to amend the EA dated 03 May 2016 as follows:

Amendment:

The applicant applied to amend the co-ordinates on page four (4) of the Environmental Authorisation:

The EA amendment is subject to the following conditions:

- The Refined Layout and Environmental Sensitivity Map dated 09 February 2017 (attached as motivation for the amendment in the additional information received on 16 February 2017) is hereby approved as the final site for the approved Karusa substation as this layout shows the amended substation position for the substation within the Low Ecology Sensitivity.
- No construction activities including the boundary of the substation must be located within the Medium–High Ecology Sensitivity as well as High Ecology Sensitivity.

This letter must be read in conjunction with the EA dated 03 May 2016.

In terms of regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 (the Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of the EA, of the Department's decision in respect of your application as well as the provisions regarding the submission of appeals that are contained in the Regulations.

Your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of Government Notice No. R.993, which prescribes the appeal procedure to be followed. An appellant must submit an appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant.

If the applicant wishes to lodge an appeal, it must also serve a copy of the notice of intention to appeal on all registered interested and affected parties as well as a notice indicating where, and for what period, the appeal submission will be available for inspection, should you intend to submit an appeal.

In the instance where an appeal is lodged, you may not commence with the activity until such time that the appeal is finalised.
