This advertisement serves to inform you, as a potential Interested and Affected Party (I&AP), of the proposed application for Environmental Authorisation: Expansion of the Excelsior Abattoir - Kuruman. The application will be lodged at the Northern Cape Department of Agriculture, Environmental Affairs, Rural Development and Land Reform (Competent Authority) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA), 1998 (Act 107 of 1998), as amended, and the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014, as amended. A Basic EIA process will be conducted. The applicant, Excelsior Abattoir CC, has appointed EARTHnSKY Environmental (Pty) Ltd. as the Independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) for the application.
