The applicant, Eskom SOC Ltd, is proposing the decommissioning of the asbestos landfill site buried within the Ash Dam One at the Kriel Power Station situated approximately 43km south of eMalahleni, Mpumalanga Province. The proposed development falls within the jurisdiction of the eMalahleni Local Municipality and within the greater Nkangala District Municipality.

The affected property associated with the proposed asbestos landfill decommissioning is Kriel Power Station 65.

#### BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS

An integrated application for Environmental Authorisation (EA) and a Waste Management Licence (WML) will be submitted to the National Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA), the Competent Authority, in accordance with the National Environmental Management Act (No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA), Government Notice (GNR 921), and the provisions of the 2014 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, as amended on 07 April 2017, published in GNR 324 to GNR 327.

Savannah Environmental (Pty) Ltd has been appointed as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP), responsible for undertaking the Basic Assessment (BA) processes, in order to identify and assess all potential environmental impacts associated with the asbestos landfill site decommissioning and recommend appropriate mitigation and management measures in an Environmental Management Programme (EMPr).

The department and/or the organisation which you represent has been identified as a commenting authority for the proposed Asbestos Landfill Decommissioning. Transalloys (Pty) Ltd received an Integrated Environmental Authorisation (IEA) for the construction of a 55MW coal-fired power station to be constructed adjacent to the existing Transalloys smelter complex (DEA ref: 14/12/16/3/3/3/97) on 02 March 2016. The power station is to provide power to the existing Transalloys smelter plant which is situated near Clewer, eMalahleni Local Municipality located in the Nkangala District Municipality of Mpumalanga Province. Since the issuance of the IEA, technical optimisations of the authorised layout, in addition to further findings in terms of the power output potential of the plant have indicated that an improved layout and technology use could allow for up to 150MW output capacity, as opposed to the 55MW initially authorised. The amended layout still falls within the preferred site locations as assessed and approved in the initial EIA.
