

Transalloys (Pty) Ltd received an Integrated Environmental Authorisation (IEA) for the construction of a 50MW coal-fired power station to be constructed adjacent to the existing Transalloys smelter complex (DEA ref: 14/12/16/3/3/3/97) on 02 March 2016. The power station is to provide power to the existing Transalloys smelter plant which is situated near Clewer, eMalahleni Local Municipality located in the Nkangala District Municipality of Mpumalanga Province. Since the issuance of the IEA, technical optimisations of the authorised layout, in addition to further findings in terms of the power output potential of the plant have indicated that an improved layout and technology use could allow for up to 150MW output capacity, as opposed to the 55MW initially authorised. 




