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Dear Norah,

You can come in and have a look at the report or ask Debbie for a copy. We over-ruled it on the house and the developers may still contest it on that basis. Mills Circle and most of the buildings in it are not over 60 years of age and, whilst we can protect buildings that are less than 60 years old, none of these buildings are of outstanding architectural value and neither do they form a unique group. He only needs a demolition permit for the dairy farmstead and not for the other buildings in Mills Circle. I phoned Mr Christodoulou to alert him to the fact that he still needed to get permission to demolish the farmstead. He assured me that he is aware of that and is following the legal process. He said that he still has people living in the old house and is only felling trees and cleaning up the site at the moment. If I get a chance I will go round to see what he is doing. If he demolishes the remaining buildings it is not our issue.
