Consultation in terms of Section 40 of the MPRD Act 2002: A portion of the Remainder of the Farm Nababeep No. 134, Namaqualand, Northern Cape Region. Your Case No: 1821.

Our correspondence dated 26 March 2013 in this regard and your reply dated 28 March 2013 is referred to.

We wish to reply as follows:

1. You are confusing the Mining Permit application and the property. There are **no** buildings on the mining permit application area. The application area is an old mine waste dump with **no** buildings which is evident in the Layout Plan as attached. You have already exempted another Mining Permit application by Nababeep Mining Investment (Pty) Ltd (Case 1245) on the same waste dump and your reasoning now for the application of N7 Transport CC is ambiguous.
2. The **property** belongs to O'Okiep Copper Company (Pty) Ltd with various buildings, also old buildings but this is a separate issue and forms **not** part of N7 Transport CC's application. The rehabilitation work is also the responsibility of O'Okiep Copper Company (Pty) Ltd and you should approach them under separate request.
