Thank you very much for the telephone conversation regarding the above mentioned project of today.

In November 2013 SAHRA requested Aurecon to include a Paleontological Assessment for the development. Aurecon appointed PGS to undertake the requested study. On their recommendation a Phase I Desktop assessment was undertaken. The report compiled by Gideon Groenewald was uploaded on your system on 22 May 2014. SAHRA has responded in a letter dated 26 May 2014 that you would require a field-based PIA for the project.

We have forwarded your letter to our specialist service provider, PGS and Gideon and David Groenewald made the following recommendation (e-mail attached for your convenience):

"that the Phase I PIA work be included in the EMP for the project with the proviso that

- The Phase I PIA be done at the onset of construction site visits before construction (i) actually takes place
- The Phase I PIA will be upgraded to a Phase II PIA where fossils are present, (ii) and get SAHRA comments on such a recommendation."

You are therefore kindly requested to consider the recommendation by the palaeontologist that the field-based assessment be undertaken as part of the construction phase of the project and provide us with your decision at your earliest convenience.
