**NOTIFICATION LETTER: EXPANSION OF SLUDGE LAGOONS AT THE TEMBA WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS AND DEMOLISHING OF EXISTING MATURATION POND AT THE TEMBA WATER PURIFICATION PLANT**

It is the intention of the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality to expand the sludge lagoons at the Temba Waste Water Treatment Works (WWTW) and demolish an existing maturation pond at the Temba Water Purification Plant. A waste management license application was submitted at the Department of Environmental Affairs for the sludge lagoons and a decommissioning permit for the maturation pond. These activities are listed in Category B of the list of waste management activities that have, or are likely to have a detrimental effect on the environment in terms of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act No 59 of 2008).

Chameleon Environmental was appointed to undertake the environmental studies on their behalf. Notice is hereby given in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations of 18 June 2010 promulgated in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), that an Environmental Impact Assessment will be conducted for the proposed development for submission to the National Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) for authorisation. The reference number assigned to the project by the DEA is 12/9/11/L959/3. Please see a Background Information Document and locality plan with regard to the proposed project included with this letter.
