**Permit application Chiapinni Street, Cape Town
Trenches for electrical services**

Dear Itumaleng

Our company has been appointed by the City of Cape Town to monitor the replacement of electrical cables in Chiapinni Street, Green Point – De Waterkant area of Cape Town.

This Street Lies between the old DRC and Military cemeteries, both which have been investigated by ourselves and found to contain human remains. The street itself may have been part of the informal grave system that has been found in adjacent Prestwich Street and nearby Alfred Street and Napier Streets.

The proposal is to monitor cable trench excavation up the length of the street. Any human remains found will be removed as completely as possible and re-housed at the Prestwich Memorial, a consecrated burial facility “across the road” that was built for this purpose following the minister’s recommendations with respect to the Green Point area. We have on previous occasions monitored similar projects in the waterkant area.

Apparently the work is urgent therefore we look forward to a timeous result.
