



1. Background

The applicant, Mangaung Metropolitan Municipality applied for Authorisation to commence $2 \mu G_{\tau}$ with activities 44, 12 and 19 of Listing Notice 1 (GNR 327) of the 2014 EIA Regulations as Applicatic amended, described in the Basic Assessment Report (BAR) dated 11th June 2020 as the expansion of cemetery on the remainder of the farm Nalisview 2835 & portion 1 of the farm Nalisview 1060, Bloemfontein, Free State Province

The applicant appointed MDA consultants to undertake Basic Assessment process, for the activity as described under Regulation Notice 326 of 2014 EIA Regulations as amended.

2. Information considered in making the decision

Sec 24G In reaching its decision, the Department took, inter alia, the following into consideration a) The information contained in the BAR dated 11th June 2020 completed by MDA consultants and the accompanying Environmental Management Programme (EMPr). b) Mitigation measures as proposed in the BAR dated 11th June 2020 and the EMPr. Sec 24G c) The objectives and requirements of relevant legislation, policies and guidelines and Section 2 of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998). d) The findings of the site visit undertaken by Mr. F Mathibe from the Department of Economic, Small Business Development, Tourism and Environment Affairs on the 15th July 2021.

- 1.38 The applicant must ensure that at least one borehole is drilled in the vicinity of the site to determine the groundwater levels in the area.
- 1.39 In order to determine the groundwater flow direction, the applicant must use at least 2 existing boreholes as recommended in the Geohydrological Assessment Report.
- 1.40 The chlorine concentration value of the groundwater must be determined by means of sampling
- 1.41 The water monitoring plan must be revised on a regular basis to incorporate the changes in the water flow regime.
- 1.42 The laboratory analysis techniques must comply with SANS guideline and laboratories must be accredited.
- 1.43 The data must be stored electronically on a well-known database such as WISH, Aquabase or Access.
- 1.44 The applicant must ensure that on the completion of every sampling run a monitoring report is written inclusive of time series trends, Piper and Durov diagrams to determine if there is any changes in the system.
- 1.45 The applicant must submit a compliance report to Department of Water and Sanitation once a year.
- 1.46 If any evidence of archaeological sites or artefacts, paleontological fossils, graves or other heritage resources is found during construction, South African Heritage Resource Agency (SAHRA) and archaeologist and / palaeontologist, must be informed immediately depending on the nature of the findings.

- 1.32 All solid waste produced must be disposed of at an authorized landfill site.
- 1.33The applicant must ensure that 32m buffer zone is implemented between the burial sites and any water resources.
- 1.34 Storm water management measures must be implemented to prevent increased runoff velocity and erosion.



- 1.19 The ECO shall keep record of all activities on site, problems identified, transgressions noted and a task schedule of tasks undertaken by the ECO.
- 1.20 The ECO shall remain employed until all rehabilitation measures, as required for implementations due to construction damage are completed and the site is ready for operation.
- 1.21 Records relating to monitoring must be kept on site and made available for inspection to any relevant and competent authority in respect of this development.

- 1.9.2 inform the interested and affected party of the appeal procedure provided for in National Appeal Regulations published in Government Gazette No. 38559 of 12 March 2015.
- 1.9.3 advise the interested and affected party that a copy of the Authorisation will be furnished on request; and
- 1.9.4 Give the reasons for the decision.
- 1.10 A person affected by the decision who wishes to appeal against the decision must lodge an appeal with the MEC of the Department of Economic, Small Business Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs. An appeal should be directed to:

4. Findings

After consideration of the information and factors listed above, the Department made the following findings -

- (a) The wetland area will be kept clean and tidy. No construction activities will be undertaken within the buffer area associated with the wetland
- (b) Waste will be removed from site on a regular basis
- (c) Erosion control measures will be implemented
- (d) Storm water measures will be implemented
- (e) Some of the existing boreholes will be utilised to monitor the groundwater quality

In view of the above, the Department is satisfied that, subject to compliance with the conditions contained in the Environmental Authorisation, the proposed activity will not conflict with the general objectives of integrated environmental management laid down in Chapter 5 of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) and that any potentially detrimental environmental impacts resulting from the proposed activity can be mitigated to acceptable levels. The application is accordingly granted.
