ENVIRONMENTAL BASIC ASSESSMENT AND ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME, WATER USE LICENCE AND MINING PERMIT FOR THE REHABILITATION OF A NATIONAL ROUTE (N11) SECTION 13 IN MOKOPANE, LIMPOPO PROVINCE.

In January 2012 a notice was given in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations published in the Government Notice No.R543 to R544 of 2010; in terms of section 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act (Act No 107 of 1998). The South African National Road Agency Limited (SANRAL) intends to undertake to undertake the Basic Assessment Study, Public Participation Process, Water Use Licence and Mining Permit applications for this proposed project.

Due to the additional Environmental Management Specialist Studies which were conducted and included into the project, i.e Social and Noise Impact Assessments, an Environmental Basic Assessment Report and Environmental Management Programme had to be amended. Stakeholders, authorities and the public is invited to review and comment on the Draft Amended Basic Assessment (BA) Report and Environmental Management Programme (EMPr).

The draft amended Basic Assessment Report and Environmental Management Programme will be available for review for a 40 day calendar period from the **28 September2012** to **16 November 2012**.
