

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION FOR THE EXEMPTION FROM FURTHER PALAEOONTOLOGICAL STUDIES

For: Proposed platinum mine near Lesego in the Sekhukhune Area, Steelpoort, Limpopo Province

Methodology:

The geology of the region in which the proposed development of a new platinum mine in the Lesego Area, south east of Polokwane, Limpopo Province has been studied for a Scoping Report.

Findings:

The region has no palaeontological importance. The geology of the region consists of igneous rocks of the Rustenburg Layered Suite of the Bushveld Igneous Complex and metamorphosed sedimentary rocks of the Pretoria Group of the Transvaal Supergroup.

Due to the improbability of fossils occurring in the study area it is recommended that the project should be exempted from further palaeontological studies.
