**PROPOSED WATER SUPPLY INFRASTRUCTURE FOR THE FOLLOWING CLUSTERS: TSHAMAHANSI,
SEKURUWE, SEEMA, PHAFOLA, MAALA PEREKISI, WITRIVIER & MILLENNIUM PARK**

MOGALAKWENA MUNICIPALITY AREA, WATERBERG DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY, LIMPOPO PROVINCE

Your letter dated 4 February 2015 refers:

1. The Basic Assessment Report included various village clusters in the Mokopane area. A HIA was conducted by the archaeologist Marko Hutten of PGS Heritage: *Proposed Water Supply Infrastructure for the Residential Clusters of Tshamahansi, Sekuruwe, Seema, Phafola, Maala Perekisi, Witrivier and Millennium Park in the Mogalakwena Local Municipality, Waterberg District, Limpopo Province, 07 November 2013.*
2. The above mentioned assessment only focused on certain areas which required Environmental Authorisation e.g. stream crossings and reservoir sites.
3. The Mogalakwena Municipality plans to install the pipelines to the various clusters in different phases according to budget roll-out and water demand by the communities.
4. HIAs will be conducted for the various pipelines in the above mentioned village clusters before construction of the pipelines occur.
5. Mr Hutten also did a HIA for the Eastern section of the Tshamahansi village cluster's pipelines.
6. See: *Proposed Water Supply Infrastructure for the Residential Cluster of Tshamahansi in the Mogalakwena Local Municipality, Waterberg District, Limpopo Province, 11 November 2013.*
7. Mr Jaco van der Walt's assessment now focuses on the Western section of the Tshamahansi village cluster's pipelines.
8. All recommendations from the archaeologists will be adhered to.
9. Community Liaison Officers for each project will confirm with the local village inhabitants that no graves and archaeological sensitive sites are damaged/destroyed without the correct processes being followed.
10. I sincerely hope that this information clarifies the situation.
