RE: PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT OF MMADITLHOKWA CEMETERY ON PORTION 122 OF KAFFERSKRAAL 342JQ, NEAR MARIKANA, NORTHWEST PROVINCE

Tharisa Mining (Pty) Ltd intends to establish a cemetery on Portion 122 of the above farm, near their Tharisa Platinum Mine close to Marikana, for the eventual relocation of graves from various grave sites located on Kafferskraal 342 JQ that will be impacted on by expanding mining operations. The graves that will be relocated to this site will be exhumed after all due processes required by law have been correctly followed. The portion where the cemetery is to be established is the property of Tharisa Mining, and will not be mined in future. It is located on an open piece of land previously utilized for agricultural purposes. However, a Heritage Impact Assessment for the proposed development has been commissioned.
