9. RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE DECLARATION OF NATIONAL  
MONUMENTS

- 9.1 Dutch Reformed Church, Church Street, 9/2/100/7  
Victoria West

The memorandum compiled by the Regional Representative on 17 July 1991 was taken as read.

It was DECIDED to recommend to Council that the church and the erf on which it is situated be declared a national monument. (Regional Representative)

- 9.2 Corbelled House complex, T'Kokobos, Carnarvon 9/2/019/9  
District

Mr Vertue strongly recommended that the complex be declared a national monument. This was seconded by Mr Bruwer.

It was DECIDED to recommend the declaration of the complex and ten metres of surrounding land as a national monument. (Regional Representative)

- 9.3 Horsemill, Groot Kareebosfontein Farm, 9/2/019/8  
Carnarvon District

The merits and its conservation potential of the mill were discussed.

It was DECIDED to recommend to Council that the horsemill and one metre of surrounding land be declared a national monument. (Regional Representative)

- 9.4 House of Solomon T Plaatje, 32 Angel Street, 9/2/049/45  
Kimberley

The Regional Representative outlined recent developments affecting the property. It was NOTED that the Solomon T Plaatje Educational Trust had purchased the property and had sufficient funds to restore the building. It was also NOTED that the Trust was in favour of the declaration of the building and that Mr Brann had, in his private capacity, been appointed as a member of the Board of the Trust.

It was DECIDED to recommend to Council that the front facade and the two front rooms, together with the garden area between the front facade and the erf boundary at the street be declared a national monument. (Regional Representative)
