The meeting between yourself and this office refers.

VIPCON has applied for land use purposes for residential development on the farms Leeuwpoort 283 JS and Tweedam 377 JS which forms part of a Mining Right area issued to Eyethu for mining coal with reference MP30/5/1/1/2/369MR.

Eyethu Coal has indicated that they have prospected in the area you intend to develop and did not find coal as such they are not going to use it and therefore do not object to your application. The advice that we could give is to agree with Eyethu Coal to officially abandon the portions they will not mine on their Mining Right. The abandonment will allow the Municipality to apply for another land use as envisaged.
