Introduction

- The purpose of the meeting with ALE was to inspect 'Blackie' as well as to determine requirements of SAHRA with regard to any further activities concerning such 'heritage object'.
- Discussion was held regarding requirements of the National Heritage Resources Act (NHRA) pertaining to heritage objects.
- A site inspection of the new premises to which Blackie is to move was conducted. Blackie will be housed at the new facilities of ALE in Somerset West.
- An thorough inspection of Blackie was conducted by Andy Selfe (Steam in Action) and Ian Pretorius (HARASA). Blackie is currently housed at Faure Engineering, Somerset West.

Notes

- SAHRA is the responsible heritage resources agency for heritage objects. Such had been communication to representatives of ArchStation at a meeting previously held with Regina Isaacs.
- The movement of Blackie does not require a permit in terms of NHRA, where permits relating to heritage objects are required where conservation measures are to be effected and when collections are dispersed.
- Regina however requested that SAHRA be kept informed of proposals related to change in location of Blackie.
- Noted that ALE proposes to move Blackie to a warehouse facility within the next two weeks
- Proposals for a museum / interpretation center discussed. Regina noted the importance of such a centre reflecting a broad history, inclusive of stories and histories of all communities in addition to a history of technology. Overseeing a collection would not be the competence of SAHRA.

Way forward / action items

- Undertaking by client / project manager that SAHRA be informed prior to any change in location / activity regarding Blackie.
- Undertaking by client / project manager that SAHRA be informed of proposals / activity regarding heritage objects at CTS
- Way forward regarding museum / interpretation center in terms of management of collection to be determined.

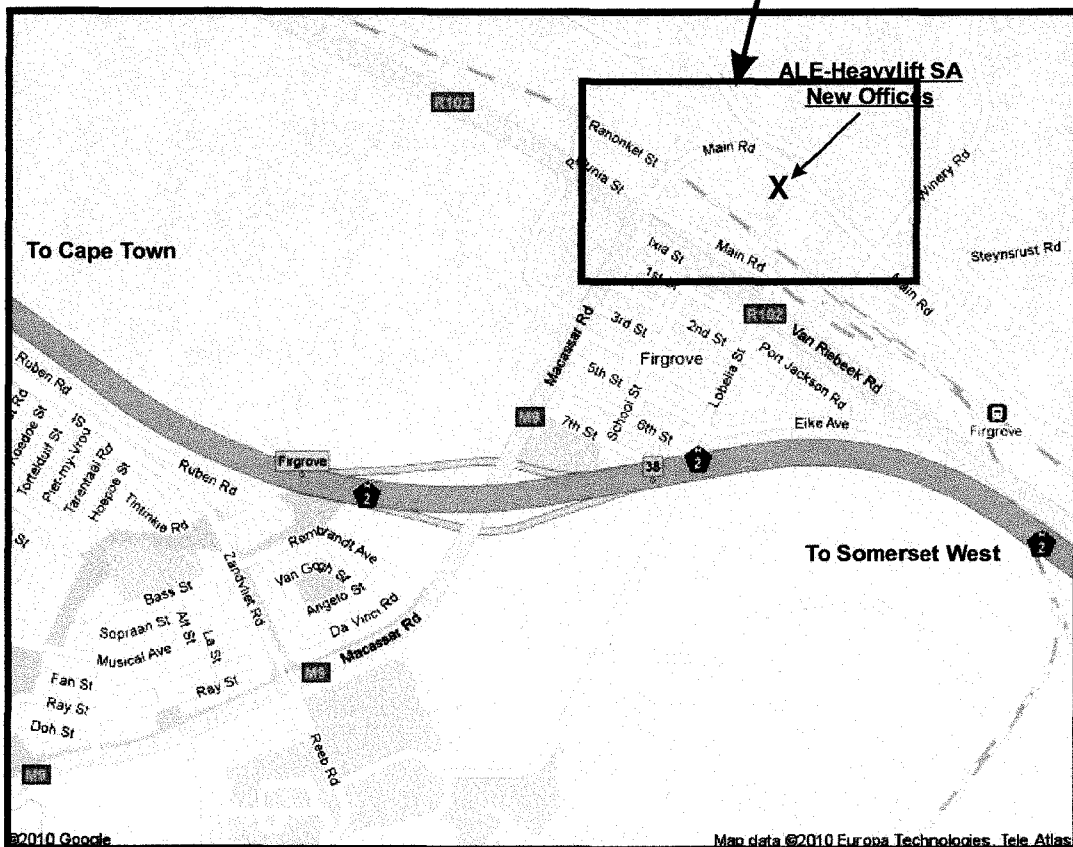
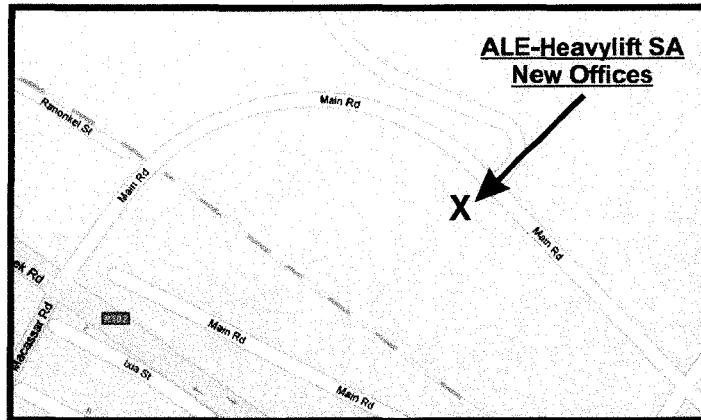

I do not know who the project manager on the railway station revitalization project is but I was hoping that you could forward the matter to the dedicated person.

The City has received a complaint from a member of the public regarding the removal of the old locomotive from its position in the station promenade. After a site visit and some research, it was discovered that the locomotive is one of the earliest declared national monuments and it was done by the then National Monuments Council in April 1936. In terms of the latest heritage legislation, previous national monuments that are moveable become "Heritage Objects" which are protected and managed by the South African Heritage Resources Agency (SAHRA).

The long and the short of the story is that the removal and/or repositioning

of the locomotive without a permit from SAHRA is a criminal offence and your client needs to be protected against any legal action. It is our recommendation that SAHRA (Regina Isaacs Tel 021 4624502) needs to be involved without any delay so as to put in place the necessary approval process for the removal of the locomotive and where it will be positioned in future.

Again I trust that you will be able to deal with the matter or relay it to the correct person as soon as possible.
