


Figure 4: Site notice placed on the boundary fence of the Remaining Extent of Portion 3 of the Farm Waterloo 730 along the N18 National Road (27°01'24.20"S; 24°45'13.70"E).




Figure 5: Notices placed at the Naledi Local Municipality (26°57'28.52"S; 24°43'17.96"E).




Figure 7: Notice placed at the Vryburg Public Library (26°57'22.92"S; 24°43'33.27"E)
