2. Motivation for proposed work (Please motivate fully – on a separate sheet if necessary)

The existing asbestos roof over the kitchen block leaks significantly in wet weather. According to a report			
issued by Mr Malcolm Chetty (Roof Inspector & Member of the Institute for Timber Construction			
the roof structure displays evident cracks and bowing timber indiciatig that the roof is under severe stress.			
There is structural damage to some tie-beams and webbing on the trusses. The weight of the existing			
asbestos sheeting upon the existing deteriorating roof structure is a 'accident wating to happen.'			
He has recommended that further remedial work rather than replacement of the existing roof could			
place the school members at risk. He therefore recommends the replacement of the existing roof & ceilings.

This opinion is supported by Structural Engineer, Bisram Maharaj of Sharman Consulting - see attached email.			

1. **Detail the alterations/additions/restorations proposed** (Briefly outline the proposal)

Owing to the urgency of the replacement of the kitchen block roof due to it's severly deteriorated state
& the time constraints owing to the need to carry out the removal of the existing asbestos under complete
evacuation of the entire building this project needs to take place in the July School Holidays. There is not enough
time or financial funding to do the entire building at this stage so only the Kitchen block portion of the roof will
be removed and replaced. The remainder of the roof over the rest of the building will be replaced at a later stage
in the near future.
Owing to the deteriorated state of the existing timber windows in this section of the building the windows will be
removed and replaced with white powder coated aluminium windows to match the size and format of the existing.
