

The grid connection solution associated with the solar PV facilities will be subjected to a separate Basic Assessment (BA) process in order to facilitate handover of this infrastructure to Eskom once constructed. You, as a registered Interested and Affected Party (I&AP) will be notified once the BA Report is available for review and comment.

Due to the proximity of the Solar PV Energy Facilities and their associated grid connection solution to one another, the public participation processes for the projects are being undertaken concurrently, providing the public with an opportunity to understand and provide comment on all the projects.

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


