WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE IN TERMS OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT: WASTE ACT, 2008 (ACT NO. 59 OF 2008) FOR THE RECYCLING AND TREATMENT FACILITY FOR THE SUPREME POULTRY PROCESSING PLANT ON PORTION 0 OF ERF NO. 166, BOTSHABELO, MANGAUNG METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY, FREE STATE PROVINCE.

As Registered Interested & Affected Party (I&AP) you are hereby informed that the Head of Department: Department of Economic, Small Business Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs (DESTEA) for the Free State Province (Competent Authority) granted a Waste Management Licence (WML) on 21 November 2022 and the WML was received by the Holder of the WML on 23 November 2022 for the above mentioned project, in terms of Section 20(b) of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008), read with the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations promulgated in terms of Government Notice (GN) No. R982 on 08 December 2014.

## **WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE**

## **APPEAL PROCEDURE**

Further to this decision, an appeal process must be implemented to provide all registered I&AP's the chance to appeal against the decision in terms of the appeal procedure provided for in the National Appeal Regulations published in Government Gazette No. 38559 of 12 March 2015 (as amended). The following steps are required of an appellant and are described below.

## **Appeal Procedure:**

Should any I&AP's wish to appeal any aspect of the decision an appellant must, within 20 (twenty) calendar days from the date of notification (before or on 11 January 2023; excluding the period between 15 December 2022 and 05 January 2023) –

- 1. A person affected by the decision who wishes to appeal against the decision must lodge an appeal with the MEC of the DESTEA within 20 calendar days after being notified of the decision;
