The meeting held on 7 February 2012 at your offices in Port Elizabeth and including yourself representing the Department of Economic Development, Environmental Affairs and Tourism (DEDEAT), Elliot Motsoahole and Gerrit Du Plessis from Transnet National Ports Authority (TNPA), Charlo Marston from OilTanking Grindrod Calulo (OTGC), and Ismail Banoo, Rohaida Abed and Paul Lochner from CSIR has reference.

As you are aware, OTGC are proposing to construct and operate a Bulk Liquid Storage and Handling Facility in Zone 8 of the Coega Industrial Development Zone (IDZ). As the appointed Environmental Assessment Practitioners, the CSIR submitted an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Application Form to DEDEAT on 18 July 2011.

In terms of the progress made thus far, a Background Information Document was compiled and made available to Interested and Affected Parties for a 30-day comment period extending from 20 September 2011 to 19 October 2011. Thereafter, the compilation of the Draft Scoping Report (DSR) was initiated to include responses to the comments received during the initial public consultation phase. Following several discussions regarding the project description and the approach, the DSR is now complete and we aim to release it to the public in February 2012 for a 40-day comment period. We also intend to present the DSR at the upcoming Coega Environmental Liaison Committee meeting scheduled for 23 February 2012.

As discussed during the abovementioned meeting, additional listed activities have been identified, in terms of Government Notices 544, 545, and 546 for the proposed project. Based on this, we wish to amend the EIA Application Form in order to include the additional listed activities. 


