## **PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF THE OLIFANTSHOEK SUBSTATION AND POWER LINE, NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE**

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### **NOTIFICATION OF BASIC ASSESSMENT AND WATER USE LICENCE APPLICATION PROCESSES**

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The Northern Cape, and in particular, the north east region as a whole has been earmarked for the development of various mining developments and operations. With an increase of such developments, the region of Olifantshoek has undergone rapid population expansion, and as a result there is greater pressure being placed on existing electrification networks and services to meet the current capacity demands of the region. Eskom Holdings SoC Limited's (Eskom) is therefore proposing to establish a new Olifantshoek 10MVA 132/11kV substation and 31km 132kV power line to strengthen the electrification network of the area. This project is referred to as the Olifantshoek Substation and Power Line and will consist of the following activities and infrastructure:

- » Construction and operation of the new 10MVA Olifantshoek 132/11kV substation (approximately 100m x 100m) and Ancillaries (including a metering station, control building, admin building, workshop and associated infrastructure).
- » The construction of a new 132kV single circuit overhead power line (31km long in a 32m wide servitude) from the new Olifantshoek Substation to the existing Emil Switching Station, and Ancillaries (including access tracks/roads, laydown areas, operational and maintenance facilities).
- » Decommissioning of the existing 22/11kV 2.5MVA Olifantshoek Substation including all site rehabilitation and preservation.

Two alternative substation sites and two alternative power line routes are being considered within the Basic Assessment (BA) process. The majority of the length of the power line will run parallel to the existing Ferrum/Nieuwehoop 400kV and Ferrum/Lewensaar 275kV lines. A corridor of 300m in width will be assessed for the siting of this project in order to allow for optimisation of the power line route in order to, *inter alia*, accommodate specialist findings where necessary. Within this corridor, a servitude of 32m will be negotiated with the affected landowners.

Access roads (of up to 4m in width) will be constructed along the servitude where required. The power line is proposed to be constructed, owned and operated by Eskom.

The project site is located within both the Gamagara Local Municipality of the John Taolo Gaetsewe District Municipality, and the Tasebane Local Municipality of the ZF Mgcawu District Municipality. Farm properties affected by the development include: Lanham 539, Fritz 540, Wright 538, Bredenkamp 567, Brooks 568, Beaumont 569, Murray II 570, Cox 571, Hartley 573, Neylan 766, Neylan 574 and Erf 155.

### **BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS**

In terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations published in terms of Section 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA, Act No. 107 of 1998), Eskom Holdings SoC Limited requires authorisation from the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) (in consultation with the Northern Cape Department of Environmental Affairs and Nature Conservation (DENC)) for the undertaking of the proposed development. In terms of Sections 24 and 24D of the National Environmental Management Act (No 107 of 1998), as read with the EIA Regulations of GN R982, GN R983 and R985, a Basic Assessment process is required to be undertaken for the proposed project. In terms of the National Water Act (Act No 36 of 1998), a Water Use License is required for watercourse crossings along the power line route.

**Eskom Holdings SoC Limited** has appointed **Savannah Environmental (Pty) Ltd**, as the independent environmental consultant, to undertake the required Basic Assessment and Water Use Licence Application (WULA) processes. The Basic Assessment will identify and assess the potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed project, and recommend appropriate mitigation and management measures in an Environmental Management Programme (EMPr). The Public Participation Process, which forms part of the overall Basic Assessment and WULA processes, will also be undertaken by Savannah Environmental.

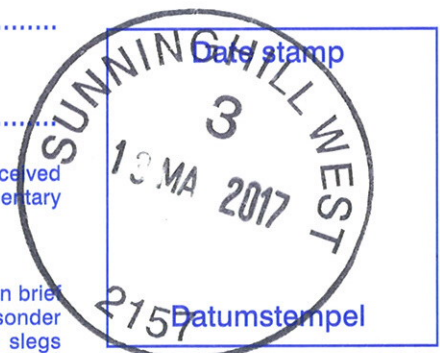

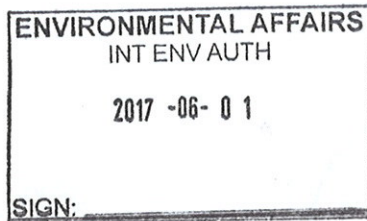

## **BASIC ASSESSMENT AND PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS**

### **132/11KV OLIFANTSHOEK SUBSTATION, NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE**

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#### **NOTIFICATION OF BASIC ASSESSMENT REPORT REVIEW PERIOD**

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The Northern Cape, and in particular the north east, region as a whole has been earmarked for the development of various mining developments and operations. With an increase of such developments, the region of Olifantshoek has undergone rapid population expansion, and as a result there is greater pressure being placed on existing electrification networks and services to meet the current capacity demands of the region. Eskom Holdings SOC Limited (Eskom) is therefore proposing to establish a new 10MVA 132/11kV substation, to be known as the 132/11kV Olifantshoek Substation, to connect a proposed 132 kV power line<sup>1</sup> between the existing Eskom Emil Substation and the new 132/11kV Olifantshoek Substation. The new Olifantshoek Substation will replace the existing substation due to the current substation not having sufficient capacity to cater for the town of Olifantshoek.

The proposed project will consist of the following activities:

- » A new 10MVA 132/11kV Olifantshoek Substation (approximately 100m x 100m in extent) and ancillaries (including a metering station, control building, admin building, workshop and associated infrastructure). Access roads of 5m in width will also be established.
- » Decommissioning of the existing 22/11kV 2.5MVA Olifantshoek Substation including all site rehabilitation.

The assessment of the new 132/11kV Olifantshoek Substation formed part of an application previously undertaken for the project which included the assessment of both the 132/11kV Olifantshoek Power Line and the new Substation (DEA ref.: 14/12/16/3/3/1/1781) within one consolidated application. However, due to the fact that the Gamagara Local Municipality will be constructing and operating the proposed substation (even though Eskom is the applicant) it was decided by Eskom to apply for a separate Environmental Authorisation from the Department of Environmental Affairs for the 132/11kV Olifantshoek Substation such that a separate Authorisation for this infrastructure could be obtained.

## **BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS**

In terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations published in terms of Section 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA, Act No. 107 of 1998), Eskom Holdings SOC Limited requires authorisation from the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) (in consultation with the Northern Cape Department of Environmental Affairs and Nature Conservation (DENC)) for the undertaking of the proposed development. In terms of Sections 24 and 24D of the National Environmental Management Act (No 107 of 1998), as read with the amended EIA Regulations, 2014, of GN R 326, R327, GN R325 and R324, a Basic Assessment process is required to be undertaken for the proposed project. The project has been registered with the DEA and the reference number will be made known in due course.

Eskom Holdings SOC Limited has appointed Savannah Environmental (Pty) Ltd, as the independent environmental consultant, to undertake the required Basic Assessment processes. The Basic Assessment identifies and assesses all the potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed project, and proposes appropriate mitigation and management measures in an Environmental Management Programme (EMPr). The Public Participation Process, which forms part of the overall Basic Assessment process, will also be undertaken by Savannah Environmental.



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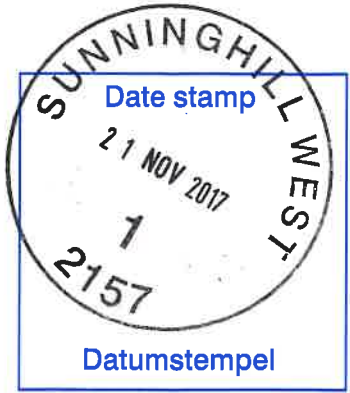
