#### APPLICATION FOR PERMIT: BURIAL GROUNDS AND GRAVES

Please note: Permit Applications expire one year after the date of receipt.

In terms of Section 36 (3) of the National Heritage Resources Act, 1999 (Act No. 25 of 1999) no person may, without a permit issued by the relevant heritage resources authority:

(a) destroy, damage, alter, exhume or remove from its original position or otherwise disturb the grave of a victim of conflict, or any burial ground or part thereof which contains such graves;

(b) destroy, damage, alter, exhume or remove from its original position or otherwise disturb any grave or burial ground older than 60 years which is situated outside a formal cemetery administered by a local authority; or

(c) bring onto or use at a burial ground or grave referred to in paragraph (a) or (b) any excavation equipment, or any equipment which assists in the detection or recovery of metals.

Other application forms are available for archaeological and palaeontological material and sites (302), for shipwrecks (303), for the export or sale of heritage objects including archaeological and palaeontological material, material from shipwrecks and meteorites (304), for the built environment and landscape (307) or the registration of private collections (402).

*PGS Heritage* (PGS) has been contractually appointed by *Synergistics Environmental Services* (Synergistics) to undertake a relocation process for an existing gravesite on the property, in compliance with Section 36 of the National Heritage Resources Act (NHRA) 25 of 1999. This contract provides for all aspects of relocation.

At this stage the age of twenty-two of the graves is unconfirmed, as they have no identifying features and have not been claimed by next of kin (NOK). According to the NOK, the twelve graves that have been identified date from 1959 to 1976. As the settlement dates back to the early 1950s, it is conceivable that at least some of the unidentified graves may be older than 60 years.

## **10.** Brief description:

The site is an informal cemetery of thirty-four stone packed graves, twelve of which have been identified by NOK and twenty-two which are unknown. The graves are loosely arranged in two rows, one with 18 and the other with 16 graves. All the graves are orientated east/west, as can be expected from modern burial practices. The graves will be relocated as part of the Resettlement of the entire town of Dingleton (formally known as Sishen) to a site on the South Eastern side of Kathu. (see Section C for more details). NB: The property is owned by Transnet and used to be a railway servitude. However, the

railway line has been relocated and the property will be affected by the expansion of the Sishen Iron Ore Mine (Anglo American).

#### **11.** Evidence for date of grave(s):

None of the affected graves have any formal headstones, thus making the dating of the graves problematic. During the social consultation it became clear that the area surrounding the cemetery was occupied by contract workers (and their families) working for the old ISCOR. Apparently the settlement was known as "Scoudon Kamp" (the spelling is unclear) and as far as can be discerned it was occupied from the 1950's until the 1970's/80's, although one person allegedly stayed there until the late 1990's (this claim could not be verified). The remains of the settlement can still be seen clearly in the area. The graves that have been identified date from 1959 to 1976. As the settlement dates back to the early 1950s, it is conceivable that at least some of the unidentified graves may be older than 60 years. The cemetery is colloquially known as the 'Spoornet begraafplaas' or 'Scoudon Kamp begraafplaas', as it is situated next to the railway line and an associated sub-station, and once serviced the inhabitants of the Scoudon informal settlement.

#### C. REASON FOR APPLICATION

#### 14. Purpose of and reasons for application:

The graves will be relocated as part of the Resettlement of the entire town of Dingleton (formally known as Sishen) to a site on the South Eastern side of Kathu. The Sishen Iron Ore Company proposes to resettle the residents of the town of Dingleton, situated immediately west of the current Sishen Iron Ore Mine (Sishen Mine) pit, to the Phase 4 (f-h) development on the farm Sekgame 461 directly south-east of Kathu. The resettlement of the Dingleton residents is not only necessary to improve their living conditions (including health, safety, general service delivery), but is also integral to the continued economic viability of Sishen Mine. The Sishen Mine Environmental Management Programme Report (EMPR), as approved by DME in 2002, indicates that the opencast mine pit will progress westwards, impacting upon the 500 m buffer zone between the town of Dingleton and the Sishen Mine pit. The pit expansion will therefore require the demolition / decommissioning of Dingleton Town (including structures and buildings such as houses, churches, shops, tar roads, a petrol station, the sewerage treatment works, this informal graveyard, etc) and the old Sishen Mine South Plant area.

## D. PREREQUISITES FOR PERMIT

17. Please indicate what arrangements have been made for the exhumation and re-interment of the contents of the grave(s)(provide documentation and details):

All excavation, archival and research work as well as social consultation will be handled jointly by PGS Heritage and a local registered funeral undertaker (to be appointed)

The remains will be reburied in the Kathu Municipal Cemetery in accordance with the requirements of the *bona fide* interested and affected parties, as identified by an ongoing public consultation process. The aim is to recreate the layout of the existing cemetery in the new place of reburial.

PGS Heritage has been appointed with sufficient financial provision to conduct the process in compliance with relevant legislation and to industry best practice standards.

#### Legal notices

- Legal notices in English, Afrikaans and seTswana were placed at the cemetery on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of November 2011. The notices are still in place at the cemetery and will stay there until the completion of the project.
- The same notices were published in the Daily Sun and the Kathu Gazette in March 2012.
- An article about the grave relocation project was published in the Dingleton Resettlement Working Group's March 2012 edition of their "The Resettlement News" newsletter.
- Copies of the newspaper notices have been handed to the identified NOK for distribution in the areas where they stay.

The only feedback received on the newspaper notices was from inhabitants of the town of Kathu who thought that the cemetery to be relocated was the old Sishen Municipal cemetery situated next to the Gamagara River.

#### Social consultation meetings

The aim of the social consultation process is to identify the NOK of the persons buried in the affected graves, inform them about the relocation process and get permission from them for relocation should they have no objection. The NHRA (No 25 of 1999) stipulates that a <u>concerted effort</u> must be made to identify and consult with the NOK and other interested and affected parties. To date the following three visits were made to Dingleton with the aim to accomplish just that:

## 21-22 February 2012.

During the visit, a great deal of time was spent to identify persons in Dingleton who knew about the existence of the graves and the whereabouts of the NOK. A large number of residents were interviewed, with the result that one of the NOKs, Mr. Petrus (Yster) Mohlale, was identified. Mr Mohlale's grandfather was buried in the cemetery in 1972. With the help of Mr Mohlale, the consultant was able to arrange a follow-up meeting with NOKs from Kuruman. Mr Mohlale volunteered to look for more NOKs and alert them to the date of the next meeting.

A visit was also made to the Dingleton South African Police Service (SAPS) to inform them about the relocation process. The consultant spoke with Captain Hikwana who was very helpful in providing names of persons who might be able to be of assistance.

## 17-18 March 2012.

The following NOKs were interviewed:

- Ms Sanna Hoorniet (Kuruman) who is the sister of the late Mr Oupiet Hoorniet (1934-1969), who is buried in the 'Spoornet' cemetery. The process was explained to Mrs Hoorniet and she was happy to sign the permission form for the relocation.
- Mrs Rachel Nthakeng (Dingleton) has one grave in the cemetery, that of her sister Angelina Matiti (1960-1975). Once again the process was explained to Ms Nthakeng and she signed the permission forms.

Apart from interviewing the above persons, time was spent on trying to identify additional persons who could be of help. To this end the consultant spoke with the councillor of the area, Mr Victor Gorra. Mr Gorra was very helpful and promised to spread the word about the grave relocation in the community. With the help of the identified NOK, the consultant was once again able to arrange for follow up meetings. During the social consultation process it became clear that most of the affected families have long since relocated from the Dingleton area, making their identification very difficult.

## 20-21 April 2012.

The following NOK were interviewed:

- Ms Martha Mafalale (Kuruman). Ms Mafalale gave permission for the grave of her father, the late Joseph Bam (died 1976) to be relocated.
- Ms Dipuo Setlhoke (Loopeng, 100km north of Kuruman) gave permission for the relocation of two of her siblings: Moseku Bengu (died 1959) and Kgakolo Bengu (died 1962). Ms Setlhoke acted on behalf of her mother, Ms Arina W Bengu, who was present at the meeting but is illiterate and therefore unable to sign the permission form.
- Mr Petrus Mohlale (Dingleton) indicated that he would sign the requisite permission form to relocate the remains of his grandfather at the next meeting.
- The consultant also spoke to Ms Marie Bojosi (Dingleton) who has two relatives buried in the affected cemetery. She indicated that we should speak with her sister, Ms Yvonne Pebe, regarding the relocation.

#### June and July 2012.

The social consultation visit to the project area on 9 June 2012 was largely unsuccessful as no new family members were identified. The consultant made contact with Mr. Jan de Wet, one of the local inhabitants who claimed that he knew of 2 more family members staying in the Kuruman area. Unfortunately he did not know their whereabouts or contact details. He promised to forward the information as soon as he could.

The following permissions were obtained as the result of the conversation with Ms Marie Bojosi (see above):

• Ms Pebe was contacted and signed the necessary permission forms for the relocation of two of her siblings. These were faxed to the consultant. The original copies are still in the possession of Ms Pebe.

#### August 2012.

A consultant from PGS met with representatives of two families in Kuruman and Kathu respectively. The following permissions were subsequently obtained:

• Mr. Richard Sehularo was interviewed in Kuruman and gave permission for the relocation of two of his siblings, namely Kesenugile and Keditlwetse Sehularo. Mr Sehularo initially wanted the reburial of the remains to take place near his home in Magojaneg village, but when the consultant contacted him afterwards to ask if the remains could be reburied in Kathu, he gave permission for this.

• Mr. Joshua Mosiapoa was interviewed in Kathu and gave permission for the relocation of two of his siblings (Petrus and Othusetse Mosiapoa).

During the social consultation process, permission was obtained for the relocation of 12 of the 34 affected graves (35%). Although this percentage is on the low side, given the fact that the settlement was abandoned more than 30 years ago, we feel confident that we have done our best in locating the NOK of the buried individuals.
