REQUEST FOR RENEWAL OF PERMIT ORIGINALLY ISSUED BY SAHRA APM UNIT (2008), FOR THE RELOCATION OF 26 GRAVES AT CHLOOKOP EXT 48, KEMPTON PARK, GAUTENG

Please see the attached application form for a permit to relocate 26 graves identified on plot 5343, Chlookop Ext. 48 (Portion 43 of Mooifontein 14-IR), Ekurhuleni Gauteng. As noted above, this application is a resubmission of a previous application for the same graves, for which a permit was issued by the SAHRA Archaeology Palaeontology and Meteorite (APM) Unit in 2008 (Permit No. 80/08/08/007/51), authorising the relocation of 26 graves comprising an informal cemetery on the property.

NB: However, in the interim, there was an extended delay on the client's side in obtaining the finalized township establishment and section 82 certificate. This was obtained only this year. Therefore, the exhumation did not take place. The original SAHRA permit has therefore expired (since it was issued in 2008) and so PGS is re-submitting the application to the Burial Grounds and Graves Unit of SAHRA for renewal.

The legal notices required in terms of the relevant legislation have been re-published in the Beeld and the Daily Sun newspapers and a new application is also in progress with the Gauteng Department of Health. The family member who previously gave consent for the removal (Mrs Gladys Wilken) has renewed her consent. The other family members who were previously represented by Mr Britz, have now indicated via Mr Britz that Mrs Wilkin is the final authority regarding permission for the grave relocation (pers.com HS Steyn, 18/09/2012). All details and relevant documents in the attached application form.

Please note that, since all the supporting documents for the initial application (specifically the communication between PGS and the relevant family members: Mrs Wilken and Mr Britz) were submitted to SAHRA with the previous application in 2008 and a permit was issued, only the latest relevant information is included with this application (newspaper notices, family permission, landowner motivation letter, copy of previous SAHRA permit).
