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1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

Canyon Resources (Pty) Ltd (Canyon) is a mining and exploration company with current operations in Mpumalanga and Gauteng. The company has four operational mines, Hakhano in the Middleburg area, Phalanndwa in Delmas area, Ukufisa in Springs and Khanye in Bronkhorstspruit area, all four are opencast coal mines mined through the typical truck and shovel method and concurrent rehabilitation is done at the sites. Canyon also has one mine in rehabilitation phase, Singani, also situated in the Middleburg area.

The proposed project will involve the development of a new Greenfields underground coal mining operation near the towns of Bethal and Hendrina in the Mpumalanga province. The mine will be located on Portion 4 of the Farm Koppie 228 IS and Portions 2, 3, 6, 9, 10, 11, 21, 27, 30, 31, and 32 of the Farm Uitgedacht 229 IS.

This document serves as the Proof of Public Participation Report and contains all documents related to the Public Participation Process.




Figure 1: Proposed Koppie Mining Project Locality
