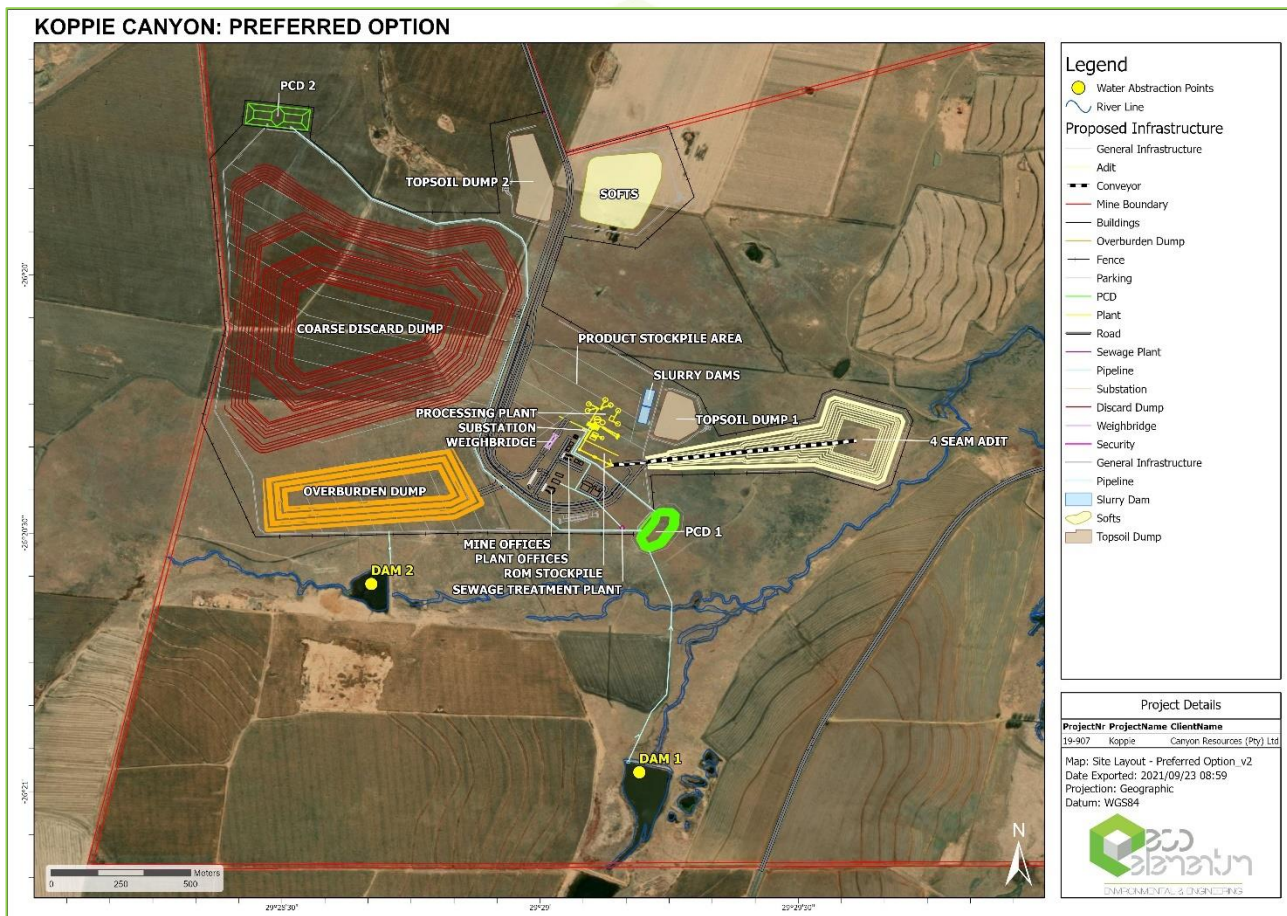


Figure 1: Proposed Koppie Mining Project Locality

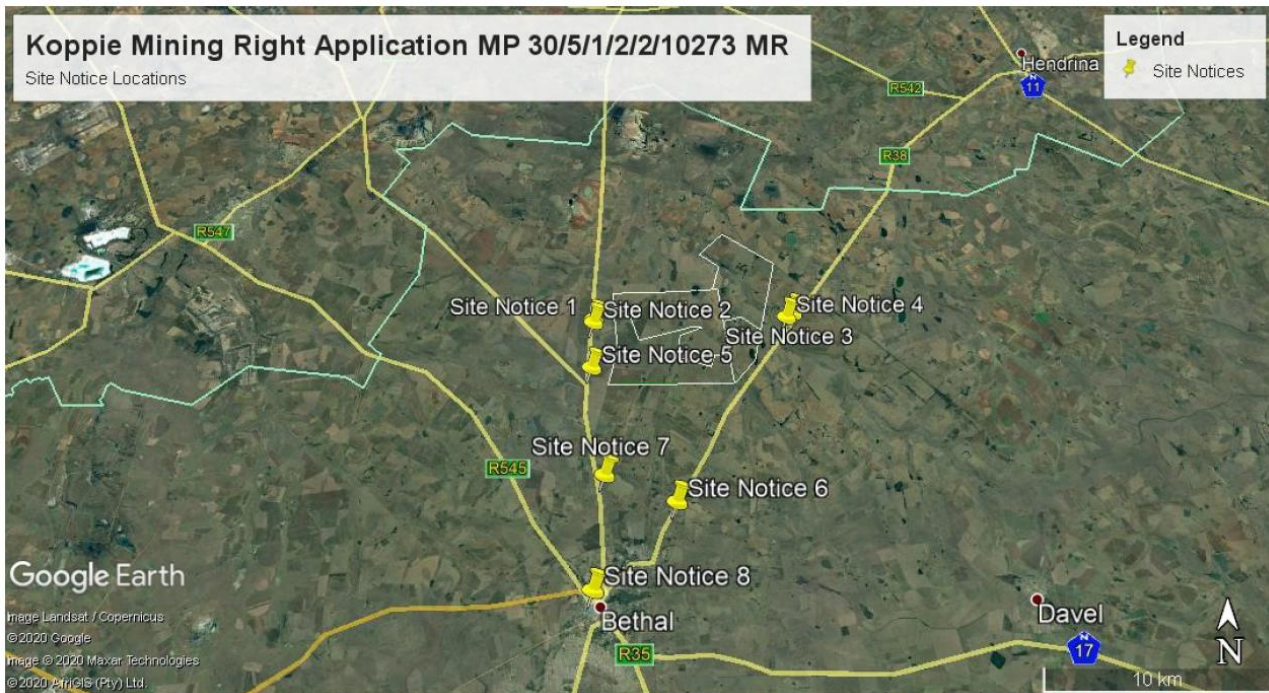


Figure 2: Site Notice Placement

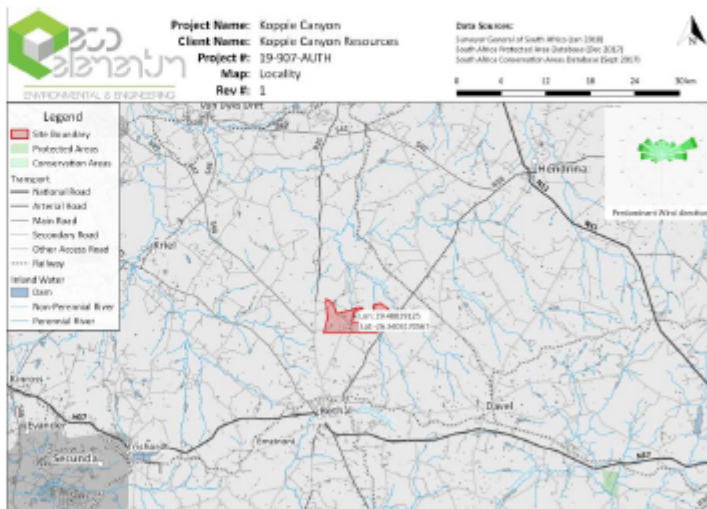

3. KOPPIE PROJECT INFORMATION

The proposed project will involve the development of a new greenfields underground coal mining operation near the towns of the Bethal and Hendrina in the Mpumalanga province. The mine will be located on Portion 4 of the Farm Koppie 228 IS and Portions 2, 3, 6, 9, 10, 11, 21, 27, 30, 31, and 32 of the Farm Uitgedacht 229 IS. Refer to Figure 1. The mining complex (main surface infrastructure) is proposed on Portions 3, 6, 21 and 27 of the Farm Uitgedacht 229 IS. The project has an inferred resource of 68,199 Million tons (Mt) of coal that will be marketed to export markets. It is anticipated that mining will involve removing ~ 150 000 tonnes of coal per month with a life of mine of 21 years. The total mining right area measures 1995,45 Hectares (ha).

As per the meeting held with Mr Paul(PT) and Trevor Friedman(TF) on the 07/Sep, Please take note of some of the comments made pertaining to the Koppie project.

- The landowners were confused with the name Koppie due to majority of the farms being Uitgedacht, hence they were skeptical to allow specialist on site.
Canyon clarified it was a name chosen to identify the project in the documents and the process conducted.
- TF asked if we have the Mining Right already?
It was explained that the current process is undertaken is to acquire the MR
- TF made reference to two irrigation dams on the boundary of ferzando, explaining that the two dams on a rainy day will fill up and then three weeks later one dam miraculously empties up. There is a genuine concern that the same will happen on their property due to the proposed project.
It was explained that the Geo-hydro specialist will conduct an assessment and a hydrocensus will be undertaken which will involve the monitoring of surrounding boreholes to confirm the baseline quality and quantity. And furthermore highlighted that this information can be used throughout the life of mine to confirm whether the mining activities are impacting the surrounding boreholes.
- PT explained that they have existing dams and boreholes that were erected before the water act therefore they are not registered , and then inquired on how that affect them in case something happens to their boreholes/dams.
Canyon acknowledges the NWA of 1998 , and assured the landowners that a just and proper procedure will be followed as long as all boreholes and dams got identified during the specialist studies to address any problems.
